<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Firstly Arrival to Egypt

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Egypt Tours will be waiting for you, holding a sign with your name. You will be escorted to your hotel in a comfortable, airconditioned vehicle, where the representative will assist you with check-in and go over your itinerary for the upcoming tours. They will also confirm pick-up times for each day, ensuring that you have a seamless and enjoyable experience during your Cairo and Sharm El Sheikh Easter Tours. You'll be welcomed with a refreshing drink upon arrival and will spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour

After enjoying a delicious breakfast buffet at your hotel in Cairo, you will meet your English-speaking tour guide to begin your Cairo Day Tour to the Giza Plateau. You will start by visiting the <u>Great Pyramid</u> of Cheops, built over 4,500 years ago and consisting of more than 2.6 million pieces of rock. Cheops had many sons, including "Ghadf Raa", "Chefren", and "Hor Ghadf", but their relationships were not always smooth.

You will also see the Pyramid of Chephren, the second largest pyramid on the plateau, as well as the Pyramid of Mycerinus, which was built using both granite and limestone. The tour will also include a visit to the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a monumental statue with the head of a pharaoh, and the body of a lion, symbolizing strength and intelligence.

You will have the opportunity to take panoramic photos of all the Giza pyramids and enjoy a 15-minute camel ride. You can also choose to visit the Solar Boat behind Cheops' pyramid.

Next, you will visit Sakkara to see the Stepped Pyramid Complex, the oldest pyramid in history built by King Djoser over 4,600 years ago. You will also visit the pyramid of Teti, which has an impressive interior, and the tombs of the nobles to witness the daily life of ancient Egypt.

Finally, you will visit <u>Memphis</u>, the first capital of Egypt for 1,000 years, now known as Giza. Inside the Memphis open-air museum, you will see the famous statue of King Ramses II and an alabaster sphinx. The tour will conclude with your return to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast.

Day 3: Cairo Day Tour

Begin your next day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel before being accompanied by a professional tour guide from Cairo Top Tours to visit The Egyptian Museum.

Next, you will visit the Citadel of Saladin, constructed by the famous Islamic leader, Sultan Saladin, to defend Cairo from the Crusaders' armies. Inside the Citadel, you will see the renowned alabaster mosque built by King Mohamed Ali 200 years ago under Turkish rule for Egypt.

Your Egyptologist guide will then lead you to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, a stronghold for Christians until the Islamic conquest of Egypt. Christians believe that Jesus Christ and the Virgin Mary came to this area to escape from King Herod. You will visit the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, established in the 3rd century, and the church of St. Sergius, where Jesus and the Virgin Mary stayed for nearly three months. You will also visit the peaceful Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Afterward, you will continue to the Islamic district of Cairo to explore Khan El Khalili, the oldest bazaar in the Middle East, built over a thousand years ago.

The tour will end with your transfer back to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast.

Day 4: To Sharm El Sheikh

- After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your Cairo hotel and take you to the airport so that you can continue your Egypt tours. Meet your tour guide at Sharm El Sheikh's airport when you arrive, and he will drive you to the hotel so you can check in.

- Spend a day at leisure in the city and the night at your hotel.

Day 5: Quad Bike trip at Sharm El Sheikh

Your tour guide will pick you up at 2 P.M. from your hotel and drive you the nearly 15-minute distance to the Quad Bike Centre. Start the Quad Bike adventure after receiving a brief safety and driving tutorial. Drive through the <u>Sinai</u> desert's sand while taking in the breathtaking views. You'll come to a stop at Wadi Al-Aat's highest point after about an hour, where you can rest and sip some traditional Bedouin herbal tea. You will be driven back to your hotel in <u>Sharm El-Sheikh</u> after making your return on the bike. Spend the evening at leisure and the night at the hotel.

Day 6: Snorkeling trip to Ras Mohamed National Park

After finishing your breakfast, your tour guide will pick you up from your hotel and drive you to the sea dock where you will board a boat to sail to <u>Ras Mohamed National Park</u>. This park is home to more than 130 types of coral reefs and over 1,000 different species of fish, providing an incredible opportunity for you to explore the stunning underwater world at the <u>Red Sea Attraction</u>.

During the excursion, the boat will make three stops where you can swim and snorkel in the Red Sea. At the end of the day, the boat will return to the shore and our representative will escort you back to your hotel, arriving around (17:00).

You will spend the night at your hotel.

Day 7: Come back to Cairo

On our 7-day Cairo and Sharm El Sheikh Easter Tour, we'll serve your final breakfast. Your professional tour Leader from Cairo Top Tours will drive you to the airport in Sharm El Sheikh so you can catch your flight home for your final departure.
