Day 1: The Arrival Day

Our representative will meet you at the [Cairo International Airport](#) and take you in a private car to your 5-star hotel in Cairo or Giza.

While our representative reviews your itinerary for your Egypt tour package from Cairo to Luxor and helps you with a quick check-in, you will be given a welcome drink when you arrive at the hotel.

Cairo overnight stay.

Day 2: Cairo tour.

You will begin your first tour of the Egypt Travel Package from Cairo to Luxor after breakfast at the hotel.

Your tour guide will pick you up and drive you to [the Great Sphinx](#) and [the Giza pyramids](#), The sphinx that guards the three Giza pyramids were constructed to frighten away enemies, and the lion's body represents strength and power.

After that, you'll be eating lunch at a nearby restaurant.

The [Egyptian Museum](#) will be our next stop after that. It is the largest museum in the middle east and one of the largest on Earth.

You will return to your hotel for an overnight stay at that point.

You may select either, please note, You will begin your first tour of Egypt after breakfast at the hotel, whether it be a tour of the Giza pyramids, the Sphinx, and the Egyptian Museum, or a tour of the old Cairo and the [Khan el Khalili Cairo](#) Bazaar once we arrive in the old Cairo.

Day 3: Luxor attractions.

It was day three of the tour. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, prepare your luggage for the A/C car ride to the Cairo international airport. The Karnak temple, which is about three kilometers south of [the Temple of Karnak](#) and once connected by a walking road lined on both sides by statues of the Great Sphinx, is where

your journey in Luxor will begin once you arrive at the airport serving Luxor. This temple offers a rich record of Egyptian civilization.

You will then visit [the Luxor Temple](#), Four elegant red granite pillars, each with a crown resembling a bundle of papyrus stems, stand in front of these booths. The sacred boat of the god Amun-Ra was housed in the middle compartment, the goddess Mut's sacred boat was in the western compartment, and the moon god Khonsu's son's sacred boat was in the eastern compartment. The Hatshepsut Temple is our final stop. The majority of us are aware that the large temple was constructed by [Queen Hatshepsut Temple](#), but to learn the full story behind its construction, you must sign up for the 4-day Cairo to Luxor tour.

Lunch in a Chinese restaurant in Luxor, followed by a return trip to your hotel on air-conditioning wheels for a sound night's sleep.

Day 4: Last day

On the fourth day of the Cairo to Luxor, return your luggage in the morning and get ready to take an AC coach to the Luxor International Airport and fly to Cairo, the capital of Egypt.
