Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will meet you and take you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza. The hotel staff will assist you with the check-in process and give you a tour of the hotel. After some rest, you'll be ready to embark on your trip the following day.

To start your stay off right, you'll be served a refreshing welcome drink upon arrival at the hotel. Spend the night in Cairo and get ready for your exciting adventure ahead.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

Start your day with a delicious breakfast before embarking on your Siwa Oasis excursions.

First, visit the remnants of <u>the Shali Fortress</u>, where the ancient Siwan people sought refuge from outside attacks. Next, you'll see the 26th Dynasty-era Temple of The Oracle in Aghurmi Village, as well as the Temple of Um Ubeyda and another temple honoring Amun Ra. You'll also learn about Siwa's priceless heritage during a visit to the Siwa House Museum, and lunch will be served at one of the Oasis's delightful restaurants.

After exploring the beautiful Shali Fort and doing some shopping, take a short drive to see the impressive <u>Mountain of the Dead</u>, This stunning landmark is just over a kilometer north of Shali and features four tombs from different periods of history, including Ptolemaic, Roman, and 26th Dynasty monuments carved into the rock.

Spend a leisurely afternoon at <u>Cleopatra Spring</u>, one of the most well-known hot springs in Siwa Oasis. You'll have the opportunity to swim and soak in the sparkling water before being taken to Fitnas Island to witness the picturesque sunset.

Day 3: A safari over the Egyptian desert to the Great Sand Sea

Start your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel before embarking on your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari tour. With your licensed Egyptologist guide, you'll take a 4x4 tour of <u>the Great Sand Sea</u> and make a special memory.

We'll begin by visiting the Mountain of the Dead and many of the tombs of the Oasis' kings before moving on to the beautiful sand dunes and fossilized corals from the Cambrian era. We'll then drive to a stunning lake in the middle of the desert, where you may be lucky enough to spot flamingos enjoying the serenity of the desert and bathing in a tranquil manner.

Next, we'll pass by <u>Dakrour Mountain</u> before enjoying the thrill of sandboarding down the sand dunes. After sandboarding, we'll take a relaxing dip in the hot spring known as <u>Bir Wahid</u> to soothe our muscles. Finally, we'll take in another breathtaking sunset at the end of the Great Sand Sea Tour while sipping Bedouin tea in the middle of the dunes. After the tour, we'll take you back to the eco-lodge for the night. Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.

Day4: Back to Cairo

Enjoy an early breakfast box before departing from Siwa Oasis via <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> for Cairo. Once we arrive in Cairo, we'll take you to your hotel for the night. If we arrive back in Cairo earlier than expected, you may have the opportunity to reserve an evening activity such as a belly dancing and Tanoura dance performance while dining on an optional Nile cruise aboard a sailing boat on the Nile River.

Day 5: Giza Pyramids Tour, Egyptian museum

After having breakfast at the hotel, a representative from our company will meet you in the lobby to assist you with your <u>Egypt tours</u>, Your first stop will be the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will be amazed by the size of these enormous structures that were built during the Old Kingdom of ancient Egypt by the greatest kings and rulers.

Visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, who was inspired by his father's attempts to build expansive burial tombs, and King Snefru, the founder of the 4th dynasty and owner of two great pyramids in Dahshur. Then, head to the high plateau for a breathtaking view of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of Chephren, who was the son of Cheops and the successor of King Djedefre. His pyramid was somewhat smaller than his father's.

Next, visit the Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a man with a lion's body thought to have been made for King Chephren himself because it is located within his funerary complex. You may have the option to ride a camel on the plateau surrounding the Giza Pyramids. After that, enter the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial process.

Continue your tour in Cairo by visiting the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which houses the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. After your 2-hour tour is finished, enjoy lunch at a high-quality restaurant before being taken to the Islamic <u>Khan El Khalili</u> area for a fascinating walking tour of Cairo and a close-up look at the Egyptian locals. After your Cairo City Tour is finished, you'll be driven back to the hotel for the night.
