Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you and take you to your hotel in a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle. At the hotel, you'll be welcomed with a refreshing drink and our representative will help you check in smoothly. They will also go over your itinerary with you and confirm the pick-up times for each of your tours during your Cairo Short Break During the Easter tour. Enjoy your first night in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sakkara Trip

Start your day with a delicious breakfast at your Cairo hotel before meeting your tour guide for an unforgettable Cairo Day Tour. First, you'll visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, one of the three pyramids at Giza. Completed around 2560 BCE, it is one of the largest and most impressive pyramids in the world. You'll also see the Pyramids of <u>Chefren</u> and Mykerinus, along with their protector the Great Sphinx.

Afterward, you'll head to <u>Saqqara</u> to explore the Step Pyramid Complex designed by the renowned architect Imhotep for King Djoser. This complex is considered the oldest stone building in the world. You'll also visit the pyramid of Teti and the tombs of the nobles at Sakkara, where you'll see daily life in ancient Egypt with all its activities engraved and painted on the walls and corridors of those 4000-year-old tombs.

Take a break for a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before continuing to <u>Memphis</u> to visit the openair museum.

Finally, you'll be transferred back to your hotel to spend the night.

Day 3 : Cairo Tours

Start your Egypt Day Tour with a delicious breakfast at your hotel in Cairo. Your Egyptologist tour guide will accompany you to the Egyptian Museum, which houses the largest collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. You'll also get to see the Treasures of the Golden Tutankhamun, the only royal treasure found intact.

Next, your personal guide and driver will take you to the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, where you can admire the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque and enjoy a panoramic view of Islamic Cairo with its centuries-old mosques, minarets, and domes.

Your tour continues to Coptic Cairo, where you'll visit the Roman fortress of Babylon, the <u>Hanging</u> <u>Church</u>, and the church of St. Sergius. You'll also get to see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is believed to be the site where Moses' basket was picked up from the Nile.

After lunch, you'll head to Islamic Cairo to explore the walls, gates, and old streets of this medieval city dating back to the 10th century. The walk ends with tea at Fishawy, one of the famous and historic cafes located in <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, Cairo's old bazaar.

Finally, you'll be taken back to your hotel to spend the night.
