<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in

At Cairo International Airport in Egypt, our tour guide will be waiting to greet and assist you. After that, we will transport you to your Cairo lodging in a climate-controlled car.

Day 2: Pyramids, Memphis, and Sakkara

To beat the crowds and the heat, start your day early by taking your breakfast then head to the Pyramids of Giza. Most hotels in Cairo can arrange transportation, or you can hire a taxi or use ridesharing services.

Arrive at the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you'll find the three famous pyramids: the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure. These are some of the last remaining wonders of the ancient world.

There are food vendors and restaurants in the vicinity of the Giza Plateau where you can enjoy traditional Egyptian cuisine.

After lunch, head to the ancient city of <u>Memphis</u>, which houses numerous statues, artifacts, and a colossal statue of Ramses II. This museum provides insight into the history of Memphis.

In the open-air museum area, you'll find the famous <u>Alabaster Sphinx</u>, a massive statue carved from a single piece of alabaster.

From Memphis, travel to <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, an archaeological site that is home to <u>the Step Pyramid</u> of Djoser, one of the earliest pyramid structures in Egypt. It's about a 30-minute drive from Memphis.

Return to your accommodation in Cairo. Depending on your energy level, you can either relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel (optional meal) or venture out to experience Cairo's vibrant dining scene.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day 3: Cairo to Sinai

Start your day by checking out of your hotel after the breakfast box in the morning. Make sure you have all your belongings packed and ready for the journey to <u>Sinai</u>.

Our first stop will be Wadi Al Fara. This hike stands out for its challenging rise and rapid descent. A 3-kilometer accessible off-road drive is available.

The next stop is the desert region of the Jabal Shayeb Al Banat mountain range in eastern Egypt. There are several deep canyons and wide slabs of volcanic rock on the mountain's sides. This mountain offers a variety of tourist activities, including camping, hiking paths, and rock climbing. then arrange your transportation to visit Wadi el Nogra.

Transport you to El Karm, your eco-camp.

Day 4: Sinai Day Treks

After sipping bedouin tea and getting ready for breakfast in camp, you'll be transported to Wadi Tala. Follow the direction in front of you to return to St. Catherine. Just in front of you, via a little hole in a stone retaining wall, the lower route joins Wadi Itlah. It is possible to observe clearly from this vantage point the thin water curtains that drop from the rock face after a shower, making it white and forming a V-shaped depression.

We then take you across this region of the high Sinai mountains to a Bedouin community and a sheik's tomb. It is a well-liked route since the roads that connect St. Catherine and here provide a diversity of mountain scenery. then take you back to your tent so you can relax and have lunch there.

Day 5: Sinai to Cairo

We'll transport you back to Cairo so you may check into a hotel and spend the night there after breakfast at the camp.

Day 6: Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo

On Day 6 of your Egyptian adventure, you'll explore the rich history and culture of Cairo by visiting the Egyptian Museum and discovering the historic district of Old Cairo.

Start your day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel or a nearby café.

Begin your day with a visit to the world-renowned <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, located in Tahrir Square in the heart of Cairo. This museum houses one of the most extensive collections of ancient Egyptian artifacts in the world, including the treasures of Tutankhamun.

Enjoy a leisurely lunch at a local restaurant near the Egyptian Museum. You can try traditional Egyptian dishes or opt for international cuisine, depending on your preference.

In the afternoon, head to the historic district of Old Cairo, known as <u>Coptic Cairo</u>. This area is filled with churches, monasteries, and historic sites.

The first stop on your tour of Cairo is the <u>Roman fortress of Babylon</u>, built by Emperor Trajan. It is located in a Coptic neighbourhood. Have a look at <u>the Hanging Church</u>, which was built over the castle's ruins.

We'll also take you to <u>the Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> and Abu Serga Church, two significant Coptic landmarks in Cairo that are both near the Holy Family Tomb. From your guide, learn more about

Coptic Cairo.

Then drive you back to your hotel

Day 7: Final Departure

On the final day of your seven-day journey to Cairo and the Sinai, have breakfast at the hotel before getting ready to check out. You will be picked up by your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours and taken there so you can catch your flight back to Cairo International Airport and head home.
