Day 1: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

Next, explore the most famous site in Bahariya Oasis <u>Tombs of the Nobles</u>, which once belonged to the administrators of Bahariya Oasis during the 26th dynasty.

A must-visit is the <u>Temple of Alexander</u> the Great, constructed by Alexander during his time in Egypt. It's believed that this temple could serve as a commemoration of Alexander the Great's journey to the Temple of the Oracle in the Siwa Oasis.

Additionally, explore the nearby <u>Temple of Meftella</u>, situated close to the village of Al-Qasr near Bawiti. The name Meftella originates from its proximity to a spring called Meftella, located northeast of the cemeteries.

After that. you can enjoy a delightful lunch, graciously served by the Bedouins in a traditional Bedouin house.

Later in the day, you'll embark on a thrilling 4WD Jeep ride to climb the <u>Black Mountain</u>, one of <u>Egypt's</u> most important natural tourist attractions.

Upon reaching the top, you'll be greeted with the fascinating ruins of "the English House," from where you can savor a panoramic view of Bahariya Oasis during the captivating sunset.

Day 2: White Desert - Black Desert

You'll pass through the Black Desert: it's a crater eruption entirely made of volcano jasper, known for its volcanic hills formed from ancient volcanic explosions and volcanic rocks.

The Valley of El Haize: Experience the pleasant breeze and natural beauty of the <u>Valley of El Haize</u>, located in the southernmost village of Bahariya.

Crystal Mountain: Discover the enchanting <u>Crystal Mountain</u> in Farafra Oasis, with its unique crystal rocks and breathtaking views. The rocks were once caves that transformed into limestone formations.
