It is one of the oldest and most famous markets in the Middle East, Finally, you'll go back to the hotel.

Day 4: Visit The City of Luxor and The East Bank

After finishing breakfast, you'll pack your bags and head to Cairo Airport to catch a flight to Luxor, where you'll begin a new Egypt luxury tour adventure. The first stop will be the Temple of Karnak, where the Egyptians celebrate the phenomenon of the sun being perpendicular to the temple on December 21 of each year between six to eight in the morning. Next, you'll visit the Temple of Luxor is a large ancient Egyptian temple located on the east bank of the Nile River in Luxor. It was built during the New Kingdom era, with construction beginning in the 14th century BC.

After the visit, you'll return to your Luxor Nile cruise in the evening to enjoy the breathtaking view of the Nile at night.

It is one of the best-preserved ancient Egyptian temples . After that you'll head to the Komombo Temple, The temple features impressive carvings and inscriptions that depict the daily life of the pharaohs and the worship of the two gods.

After the visit, you'll have lunch on board the cruise, which will then sail towards Aswan. Aswan is a beautiful city located on the Nile River in southern Egypt, known for its stunning natural scenery, ancient monuments, and vibrant culture.

Day 7: Aswan Day Tours
