<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo - Alamein WWII Cemetery and Museum - Siwa

The Tour Leader will meet you at your hotel to commence your Egypt Desert Safari Tours in the morning. Our first destination will be <u>Alamein</u> on the North Coast of Egypt, which is approximately a 3-hour drive from Cairo. Along the way, we will make coffee breaks and you can enjoy an informative tour of El Alamein.

During the El Alamein tour, we will visit the Museum of World War II, where you will learn about the two major battles that took place at Al-Alamein. You will gain detailed insights into the participating armies, the outcomes of the battles, and the staggering number of casualties, wounded soldiers, and missing individuals in their prime.

Additionally, we will visit the Commonwealth Cemetery, where you can pay your respects to those who lost their lives and honor their memory. As part of the Al Alamein tour, you will also have the opportunity to see the Australian, Italian, and German memorial cemeteries.

After the Al Alamein tour, we will drive for approximately 2 hours to reach Marsa Matrouh, where we will enjoy a delicious oriental lunch at a high-quality restaurant. Following that, we will continue our journey to Siwa Oasis. Once we arrive, you will check in at an eco-lodge, have some time to rest, and if time permits, you can take a dip in one of the natural hot springs to relax your muscles after the long day of driving.

Day 2: Discovering Siwa

After Enjoying your Egyptian breakfast at your hotel, The Tour leader will meet you, and we will start your Egypt Travel Packages to visit the old town of Shali at the center of the city. There, you will explore the ruins of the ancient mud-brick fortress of Shali, which was once the center of Siwa Oasis. It offers panoramic views of the surrounding oasis and is a great spot for photography.

Proceed to the most important location in Siwa, the Alexander the Great Temple (also called the Oracle of Amun Temple). The temple got its name, "Temple of Alexander the Great," after Alexander the Great visited it and used the oracle to verify that he was the Greek Zeus' son (known in Egyptian mythology as Amun Re). In the 26th Dynasty B.C., the temple was built in the historic settlement known as Aghurmi settlement.

Continue to explore the temple's ruins at Um Ubayda, which was devoted to <u>Amun</u>, Mut, and Khonso. The Temple of Amun dates back to the 26th Dynasty of ancient Egypt. It's a unique opportunity to explore an ancient religious site and connect with Egypt's storied past. The temple's historical significance, combined with the natural beauty of Siwa Oasis,

Visit the Siwan House, which was built by the <u>Siwan House</u> as a contribution to prevent their heritage

from being lost, to learn more about the culture, traditions, and tools and accessories used in daily life. After a satisfying lunch at a high-quality restaurant, spend a relaxing afternoon at Ein Guba, the spring that gave Cleopatra her name, and take a dip in its mineral- and sulfur-rich, warm natural water before being driven to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: Great Siwa Mountain - Great Sand Sea Safari - Bir Wahed Hot Spring

Start your day with a delightful breakfast at the Eco-lodge, followed by embarking on your <u>Siwa Oasis</u> <u>Desert Safari</u>. Begin by visiting the remarkable archaeological site at the Great Siwa Mountain in Maraki Village, where the first-ever human footprint was discovered, dating back to ancient times. Explore the stunning dunes as we make our way to the fossils area, where you can witness the ancient coral reefs from the Cambrian era.

Next, we will drive to one of the captivating destinations in the <u>Great Sand Sea</u>, the third-largest sand accumulation globally. Prepare yourself for an exhilarating Jeep Safari, and make a stop at a picturesque desert lake. Take this opportunity to swim alongside the friendly Tilapia fish. Get ready for an adrenaline rush with Sand Boarding, where you can slide down the massive dunes by adding wax to the bottom of the board. It may not be as fast as snowboarding, but it guarantees a lot of fun. After enjoying <u>Sand Boarding in Siwa</u>, it's time to head to <u>Bir Wahid</u>, also known as well number 1, to cleanse and rejuvenate in the soothing hot spring—a must-do activity in Siwa for ultimate relaxation.

As the day draws to a close, immerse yourself in the captivating beauty of a sunset over the Great Sand Sea, surrounded by enchanting dunes. Savor the taste of lemon-leaf Bedouin tea while taking in the mesmerizing view. Finally, spend the night in Siwa, where you can unwind and recharge for the adventures to come.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis

Start your day by having breakfast at the Eco-lodge, then embark on a tour to the rock-cut tombs located at the Mountain of the Dead (Gabal El Mauta). Explore the impressive tombs that belonged to the rulers of Siwa Oasis during the 26th dynasty, such as the tomb of SI Amon and another tomb known as the Crocodile Tomb. Although there is no evidence indicating who this tomb was built for, it gained fame for its remarkably well-preserved crocodile painting inside.

Afterwards, visit the Bedouin Village of Abu Ali to immerse yourself in the Bedouin lifestyle. Marvel at the canyon-like mountains and experience the mesmerizing echo of your voice reverberating through the silence of the surroundings. Return to Siwa and make a stop at the renowned <u>Dakrour Mountain</u>, where the mountain holds great significance for the Siwan people, as they celebrate the annual festival of Tourism in Siwa Oasis (El Syaha) there, coinciding with the first full moon of October. Take in the captivating view of yet another enchanting sunset at the magical Fitnas Island while savouring a hot local beverage and capturing your own timelapse photos. Finally, you will be transferred back to the city center to spend the night in your Eco-lodge.

Day 5: Siwa - Cairo

After breakfast, we will take a bus from Siwa to Cairo, where you'll check into a hotel for the night before taking a tour of the Bahariya Oasis the next morning.

Day 6: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis and White Desert

We will move to **Bahariya Oasis** From Cairo in the morning.

there, You will explore the Valley of the Golden Mummies by visiting the <u>Tombs of Nobles</u> at Qasr Sleem, like the rock-cut tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh, and the Valley of the Golden Mummies, which house well-preserved mummies and artefacts dating back to the Greco-Roman period. It's a fascinating glimpse into ancient Egyptian burial practises.

At the time of sunset, you will climb <u>Black Mountain</u> by 4WD Jeep to visit the ruins of the English House and get a scenic view of the whole Oasis and Salt Lake, surrounded by green date palm forests.

After that, We'll travel to the White Desert via the Black Desert, which is home to a number of small black stones and a region of volcano-shaped mountains, as well as the Valley of El Haize, which is home to the southernmost village in Bahriya Oasis and its delightful spring.

Finally, we will stop to see the quartz crystal at <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the magnificent Valley of Agabat, one of the wonderful attractions that we can find on our trips to Egypt. <u>Camping in the White Desert</u> with a chance to enjoy an astonishing sunset view while your guides cook your dinner, overnight camping in the White Desert

Day 07: Back to Cairo
