You'll explore the Siwa Oasis, including the Temple of the Oracle, Lake Fatnas, Bir Waheed's hot and cold springs, the Great Siwa Mountain, and the fossil region. The tour ends with a visit to the Alexandria Museum and The Jewelry Museum.

<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

This is the first day of the tour, where you will arrive in Cairo, the capital city of Egypt. You will be welcomed in a private air-conditioned car by a professional tour guide speaking English at <u>Cairo International Airport, then</u> you will check in to your hotel and have the rest of the day free to rest or explore the city on your own.

Meals: Dinner

Day 2: Giza Tours and Overnight in Cairo

Today, You will visit the <u>Great Pyramids</u> of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinos, which are ancient structures and one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

Between visits, lunch is provided at a nearby restaurant based on a full meal for each person; however, beverages are not covered.

You will also visit the <u>Egyptian Antiquities Museum</u>, which houses a vast collection of artifacts from ancient Egypt. Then, You will spend the night in Cairo.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 3: Cairo to the White Desert

Morning

After a long day in Cairo, you will leave Cairo and head to the Western Desert, you will visit the White Desert National Park, passing through the <u>black desert</u> located south of the Farafra Oasis.

Following that, we'll travel to the Agabat Valley. You must be present when we arrive at the <u>Valley of Agabat</u>, which is located deep within Egypt's white desert, to truly experience the place's otherworldly splendor.

Now, we will take you to distinctive limestone, chalk, and even sand rock formations emerged <u>The White Desert National Park</u> is known for its unique white rock formations, which create a surreal landscape.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis-Cairo

At 06:00 am your wake-up service

After taking your breakfast in the desert at 7:00 AM before traveling to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> located 330 km southwest of Cairo and 180 km from the Nile Valley.

You will visit <u>Crystal Mountain</u> which is famous for its quartzite crystals that compose the hill, which can be seen on the right, and the hot spring known as Bir Sigam in the Bahariya Oasis is situated on Cairo Road 7 km east of Bahariya.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 5: Day Tour to El Fayoum

Your hotel in Cairo will be picked up by our representative so you may see El Fayoum's major locations.

Today on our itinerary, we will travel to <u>Fayoum</u> is roughly 95 kilometers from Cairo. you will be taken by private A/C car.

You will visit <u>Wadi Hitan</u>, a UNESCO World Heritage site that contains fossil remains of whales, as well as <u>Wadi El Ryan</u> the only waterfalls in Egypt may be found at Wadi El Rayan and Mudawara Mountain in El Fayoum.

At a high-rated restaurant, late lunch will be provided. Transfer back to Cairo after that.

Day 6: Tour to Alexandria, Ancient Adventures

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up from your Cairo hotel and drive you to Alexandria in a modern, air-conditioned car, where you will check into the Paradise Inn Beach Resort. Hotel in Alexandria

You will visit <u>Pompey's Pillar</u> is associated fine arts marvel settled amidst the ruins of the Serapeum within the Egyptian coastal town of Alexandria.

the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa, and the <u>Roman amphitheater</u> in Alexandria, and enjoy a seafood lunch from the Mediterranean. You will also experience Ottoman and Arab traditions, along with kebabs, mixed grills, meze dips, and seafood.

at the end overnight at your hotel

Day7: Tour to Alexandria, Modern Magic

Today, we will continue our adventure in Alexandria after taking your breakfast.

You will visit the <u>Great Library of Alexandria</u> was an epicenter of learning in the ancient world, Next, take in a couple of Alexandria's best-known mosques, perhaps the Mosque of Abu al-Abbas al-Mursi and the Nabi Daniel Mosque.

then we will transfer to the <u>Montazah Palace Gardens</u>, take a ride along the corniche, and over the <u>Stanley Bridge</u>. The palace, which served as the residence of Egyptian rulers.

You will also have dinner at Abou el Sid restaurant and finish the evening at one of Alexandria's premier hotels with a special drink at a rooftop bar with a view of the sea.

Day 8: Alexandria to el Alamain

In the morning our knowledgeable tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Alexandria and drive you to <u>El-Alamein</u>, which is 106 kilometers west of Alexandria and 240 kilometers northwest of Cairo.

begin your day with a visit to the war museum in El Alamain also known as the Commonwealth Cemetery, which contains the graves of soldiers from several nations who died in the conflict.

then, spending the night at the Ghaliet Ecolodge & Spa, Siwa Hotel in Marsa Matrouh.

Day 9: Marsa Matruh to siwa

After meeting with our tour guide, we will depart to Marsa Matrouh on Egypt's Mediterranean coast.

You will see the Alexander the Great Temple, also known as the Temple of the Oracle, the temple located in the desert of Siwa in western Egypt.

afternoon, a dinner in Siwan restaurant, Lake Fatnas, and driving along the vast sandy coastline, proceed to the Cleopatra Spring for a swim.

We're taking a dip in the Mediterranean Sea as well and spending the night at the Ghaliet Ecolodge & Spa, Siwa Hotel.

Day 10: Siwa Oasis

Morning

Our program for Siwa will be dived into two days; today we will visit Bir Waheed's hot and cold springs, the Great Siwa Mountain, and the fossil region in Siwa Oasis.

Begin your trip n a Jeep 4x4 visiting Bir Waheed's hot and cold springs. Once there, you can take a dip in the hot and cold pools and enjoy the natural surroundings.

Then, head to the desert to see Great Siwa Mountain, a breathtaking archaeological site where the first human imprint dates back to antiquity.

We will continue our adventure to safari expedition to the fossil region in Siwa Oasis is an exciting

adventure that takes you through the stunning desert landscape of Egypt

Then, continue to Shaiata Lake, one of the desert's spring-fed lakes, where you can see Flamenco birds, take a relaxing springtime bath, and enjoy the tranquil atmosphere.

Dinner and sleeping at the Siwa Hotel.

Day 11: Continue your Siwa Oasis Tour

Have your breakfast to visit the top of the <u>Mountain of the Dead (Gabal El Maouta)</u>, There are a number of intriguing tombs there.

After seeing the Roman Spring Eye and Abu Sherouf, one of the Siwan Villages, you can continue on to the Dakrour Mountains. Bedouin culture can be seen there. into your hotel room.

Day 12: Alexandria from Siwa

After breakfast, your tour guide will transport you to your Alexandria hotel for the night. The Alexandria Museum, The museum's collection spans the entire history of Egypt, from the Old Kingdom to the Roman Empire.

After lunch at a nearby restaurant, we'll visit Alexandria's <u>The Jewelry Museum</u>, which houses a collection of over 30,000 pieces of jewelry. The museum's jewelry collection includes items from every era of Egyptian history, from the Old Kingdom to the Roman Empire. We'll take you back to your hotel so you can sleep.

Day 13: Cairo departure

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo airport for final departure
