Itinerary

Day 1 - arrival Cairo

Our knowledgeable guide will be waiting for you at Cairo International Airport to transport you to your 5-star hotel. As you get ready for the remainder of your stay, you'll have a peaceful and delightful first day in your hotel. You'll set out on your journey with an open mind and be prepared to take in everything Egypt tours have to offer.

Day 2 - Cairo tour

Get your breakfast at the hotel on the second day of your journey, then meet with our knowledgeable tour guide to go to the first destination, which is:

The Great Sphinx and the Giza Pyramids.

One of the seven wonders of the world, the three pyramids of the three known kings and the queen's pyramid are guarded by the great sphinx, which was constructed to frighten the enemies with its enormous size. At night, when it is completely dark, the sphinx's man-like face, which symbolizes intelligence, and lion-like body, which symbolizes power, become especially terrifying.

After that, wheels will transport you to a restaurant for lunch. then move on to the following location, which is:

Egyptian Museum.

With its extensive and diverse collection of antiquities, it is the biggest museum in the Middle East. It is the location where you can find some of the kings of ancient Egypt's coffins. Afterward, you'll enjoy a free shopping excursion.

Then it's time to return to the hotel in an air-conditioned vehicle for the night.

You can select either the tour of the old Cairo and the Khan el Khalili bazaar, or the tour of the Giza pyramids, sphinx, and Egyptian museum.

Day 3 - Luxor attractions

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you will begin the third day of your Cairo to Luxor vacation and return your luggage by private coach to the Cairo international airport. Once you arrive at the Luxor International Airport, begin your tour of the city's highlights by:

The Karnak temple:

There are four portions of this temple, the first of which receives the most visitors. The other three components are lesser temples. because it offers an extensive chronicle of Egyptian civilization

Luxor temple:

This one was built over the course of many monarchs, with Amenhotep being the first to begin construction. It is situated on the bank of the Nile River in the east.

The Hatshepsut temple is the last stop we have planned for you.

Visit and reserve this tour to learn more about it, about who constructed it, and to discover the intriguing history of this substantial temple, which was constructed over the course of 15 years.

After eating lunch at one of Luxor's oriental restaurants, be ready to ride in a car of your own back to the hotel. to spend the night and get a good night's sleep.

Day 4 - departure

When you get up early on the fourth and last day of your trip, prepare your luggage for the final time, and make plans to take an AC car to the international airport in Luxor so you can catch a flight back to Cairo.
