Day 1: Arrive to Cairo

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you'll be greeted by an Egyptian tour guide who will assist, transfer you to your hotel and answer all the questions you might have about this area. Once you've checked in, it's time for dinner! We'll take you to one of our favorite local restaurants for a delicious meal. After dinner, you're free to explore the city or relax at your hotel.

You'll spend your first night in Cairo. We can't wait to show you all the amazing sights and experiences of Egypt.

Day 2: Cairo Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast this morning, get ready to visit one of the most iconic sights in all of Egypt: the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, which are the only remaining wonder of the ancient world still standing today. Your guide will take you to see how they were built and visit their tombs. We recommend wearing cotton and white clothes for this tour to avoid the heat of the sun during the summer season, specifically in the Giza necropolis.

Next, you'll head to the Egyptian Museum in Cairo, which houses a wide collection of artifacts from ancient Egypt. Your guide will take you on an exciting tour through the many exhibits, where you'll learn about mummies, hieroglyphics, and other aspects of Egyptian culture that have lasted through time.

After the tour, we'll take you to one of our favorite local spots for lunch. Then, you can head back to your hotel for some rest before dinner. The rest of the day is free for you to do whatever activities you wish, such as shopping or relaxing at the hotel swimming pool.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor (Luxor West Bank Tour)

Today, we'll fly from Cairo to Luxor, the ancient city where King <u>Tutankhamun</u> was buried in his magnificent tomb. You'll embark on a historical tour of Luxor and Karnak temples on the West Bank of the Nile River, where you'll see your favorite sights in an entirely new light as you learn about the cultures that built them thousands of years ago.

The <u>Egypt travel package</u> will begin with a visit to <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which is one of the largest religious structures in Egypt. This temple was built by pharaohs to honor their gods and goddesses. It contains hundreds of rooms with intricate hieroglyphics depicting their lives. It's also home to some of the most stunning statues and sculptures in Egypt, for example, those of Ramses II.

Next, you'll head to <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which is located just upriver from Karnak. This site includes some of Egypt's most famous artifacts Amenhotep III's Colossi, which were part of his funerary temple. You will also see Ramses II's Great Hypostyle Hall, which has more than 1,000 columns; and King Tutankhamun's tomb.

Afterward, it's time to visit the West Bank of Luxor, where you'll find the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which is home to the tombs of Ancient Egypt's most famous kings, queens, and nobles. You'll also find the Temple of Hatshepsut, Deir el-Bahri (the Mortuary Temple of Mentuhotep II), and the Colossi of Memnon (two huge statues of King Amenhotep III).

Day 4: East Bank Tour and Final Departure

In the early morning, we will transfer you to the Airport to catch your flight back to your home. You can also book one final sightseeing tour around Luxor before your plane takes off from Luxor Airport to your home.
