After learning about the history and culture of Cairo, you'll head to <u>Ain Sokhna</u> by the Red Sea for a unique and relaxing holiday experience.

Day 1: Arrive to Cairo (Optional Sound and Light Show at Giza Pyramids)

As soon as you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be met by a representative from our team who will transport you to your hotel in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. Upon arrival, we will review the itinerary of your tour package in Cairo and Ain Sokhna with you to ensure that all of your Egypt day tours are scheduled according to your preferences. If you have any optional Cairo sightseeing tours in your mind, we can add them to your itinerary.

If you have enough time on your first night, we highly recommend attending the optional sound and light show at the <u>Giza pyramids</u>. This informative show will provide great background about Egyptian history, you should get ready for a tour of the pyramids the following day.

We will also provide you with a welcome drink upon your arrival at your hotel.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara, Memphis Trip

Your first day in Cairo begins with a buffet breakfast at your hotel, followed by a visit to the Giza Pyramids area with your certified tour guide. Your guide will provide you with a wealth of knowledge about the ancient History of Egypt as you explore this magnificent site, such as the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, which stands 146 meters tall and was built during the fourth dynasty by one of ancient Egypt's greatest kings.

During your tour of the Giza Pyramids, you'll also learn about King Cheops' family, including his father, Snefru, who built four impressive pyramids, and his son, <u>Chephren</u>, who built the middle pyramid in Giza. You'll also have the opportunity to see the Valley Temple of King Chephren and the Great Sphinx statue, which is carved in the shape of a man-headed lion and symbolizes power and intelligence.

After exploring the Giza Pyramids, you'll head to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, which is 200 years older than the Giza Necropolis. Here, you'll see the Step Pyramid complex of King Djoser of the third dynasty and the Pyramid of King Teti, who ruled Egypt during the sixth dynasty. You'll also have the chance to enter one of the tombs of the nobles, such as the tomb of Kagemni, who was the vizier of Justice and the son-in-law of King Teti and see fine examples of ancient Egyptian art.

Next, you'll visit Mit Rahina, the site of the most ancient capital of Egypt, which is now an open-air museum housing artifacts from different epochs of ancient Egyptian history. Here, you'll see the alabaster sphinx of Memphis, which is the second largest sphinx in Egypt, and the gigantic statue of Ramses II, one of the most important kings of the 18th dynasty.

Day 3: Islamic Cairo, Coptic Cairo, Egyptian Museum Tour

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel, your tour guide will accompany you on an exciting Cairo city tour, starting with Islamic Cairo trips to the Cairo Citadel. You'll see the <u>Salah El Din Citadel</u>, a medieval fortification that was built during the 12th century by Sultan Saladin to fortify Cairo

against potential threats at this time. Salah El Din recruited mercenaries to be used in the Egyptian army, but they soon gained power, wealth, and the support of the people, leading to their rule over the country before being overthrown in a famous massacre known as the Citadel Massacre.

Inside the Citadel, you'll visit the impressive Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, which is one of the highest points in Cairo and offers a clear view of the Giza Pyramids on a clear day.

Next, you'll head to Old Cairo to start the Coptic <u>Cairo day tour</u>, where you'll see some of the earliest Christian churches in the history of Christianity. The holy family visited Egypt during their journey to escape from King Herod. You'll visit the Church of Abu Serga, which was built above a crypt where the holy family is believed to have taken refuge, and <u>the Hanging Church</u> was built above two towers of the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon. Finally, you'll enter the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, which is one of the oldest Jewish synagogues in the Middle East.

After your Coptic Cairo tour, you'll enjoy a gourmet lunch before heading to the Khan El Khalili market in the Al Hussein area of Cairo's downtown. This area is full of old mosques from the 9th century, as well as mausoleums of the companions and family members of Prophet Mohamed. You'll have the chance to explore the small alleys of Cairo and enjoy a tasty tea-mint drink before being transferred back to your hotel to spend your night there.

Day 4: Tour to Ain Sokhna

After checking out from the hotel, we'll head to Ain Sokhna on the Red Sea. The drive will take approximately an hour and a half, and upon arrival at the resort, you can enjoy a relaxing time at the beach or swimming in the pool. Your buffet lunch will be served at 3:00 PM, and you'll have dinner before the night show.

Day 5: Porto Sokhna Cable Car and Back to Cairo

On your last day, you will check out from your hotel after breakfast and start your adventure right away. We'll drive to the famous resort of Porto Sokhna, which will take approximately 30 minutes, where you'll take the Cable Car (Teleferik) up the Galala Mountain to enjoy a fresh seafood lunch at a fancy restaurant with stunning views of the Red Sea and the surrounding mountains.

After lunch, you can explore the mall at the resort and take some amazing photos by the seaside before heading back to Cairo. Just let your driver know where you'd like to be dropped off in Cairo after your budget tour to Cairo and El Ain Sokhna is over.
