Day 01 :arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, a tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you and assist you with all necessary procedures. You will then be transported to your hotel for check-in and overnight stay in a private vehicle. If you wish to make any changes to the pick-up time, we will review your 6-day itinerary to ensure it does not affect the sightseeing activities planned for your trip.

Day 02: Visiting the Memphis city

After enjoying a delicious buffet breakfast at your hotel, your tour guide will meet you to take you on a tour of the ancient city of Memphis. This was once the capital of ancient Egypt and was the center of political and cultural life for thousands of years.

During your tour, you'll see the colossal statue of Ramesses II, one of the most powerful and influential kings in Egyptian history. You'll also explore an open-air museum that houses a range of statues and artifacts from the city's past.

After your tour, you'll enjoy a tasty lunch before returning to your hotel. Meals for the day will include breakfast and lunch.

Day 03: The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and sues Cannel

Have your breakfast meal served at the hotel and get prepared to continue your Egypt Classic Tours. Today your licensed tour guide will take you to visit your first site for today, the NMEC.

Egyptian Civilization National Museum, which comprises all manifestations of the richness and diversity that Egyptian civilization has had in various ages, is one of the largest international museums as well as the only one of its type in Egypt, the Middle East, and Africa. It will contain rare antiquities on its flanks from prehistoric times until now and is scheduled to open in the Museum of Civilization after the transfer of royal mummies from the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir.

One of the highlights of the NMEC is the Royal Mummies Hall, which houses the mummified remains of several ancient Egyptian pharaohs and queens, including Ramses II and Hatshepsut.

After that, we will take you to <u>the Suez Canal</u> in the <u>Ismailia government</u>. Ismailia Governorate is one of the governorates located on the eastern border of the Republic of Egypt in the middle of the Suez Canal, and is inhabited by about one million and three hundred thousand people, and includes a conservative part of the Sinai Peninsula after the administrative division in 1979.

in the Suez Canal, You will get to see the ships passing through while learning all the astonishing facts behind the canal's construction with your tour guide. after that, you will have a delightful lunch

Day 04: Alexandria

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, your licensed guide and personal driver will meet you to begin your Egypt travel package with a tour of Alexandria from Cairo. Founded by Alexander the Great in 332 B.C., Alexandria was once the capital city of Egypt for almost 1000 years until the Arab conquest in the 7th century.

Your tour will begin with a visit to <u>the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, which were originally a private tomb for a wealthy Romanized Egyptian family but later expanded to become a burial site for the common people of Alexandria. You'll then head to <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, the tallest standing pillar in Egypt, built by the people of Alexandria in honor of the Roman Emperor Diocletian.

Next, you'll enjoy views of the Mediterranean Sea before visiting <u>the Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, established in 1477 on the site where the legendary Pharos lighthouse once stood. After lunch at a nearby restaurant, you'll continue your tour with visits to the Alexandria Library and the Abu Al-Abbas Al-Mursi Mosque.

Meals for the day will include breakfast and lunch.

Day 05: El Alamein

El Alamein is a significant place with many museums, memorials, and cemeteries dedicated to the

battles fought there. The El Alamein War Museum is a popular attraction as it displays items, photographs, and personal accounts from the battles.
