Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our friendly Cairo Top Tours representative will be there to welcome and assist you. They will help you with passport control and collecting your luggage. Afterward, you'll be taken to your hotel for check-in, where you'll spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - the Egyptian Museum and Khan EL Khalili Bazaar.

After having breakfast at your hotel, an experienced tour guide will accompany you to explore the Great Pyramids of <u>Cheops</u>, Chephren, and Mekerinus the only remaining wonder of the ancient world. You'll also have the opportunity to see the iconic Sphinx and visit the Valley Temple located near the magnificent statue.

Next, we will continue to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, housing the world's most extensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts, including the belongings of the young King Tutankhamun and a myriad of other captivating relics. Moreover, you'll have the chance to explore the mummy's room within the museum premises.

Following the museum visit, we will head to <u>Khan El Khalili Bazaar</u>, a vibrant marketplace that holds historical significance in Cairo. Originally a mausoleum called "El Zaafran" for Fatimid Caliphs, it later evolved into a district for the Turkish community during the Ottoman era. Today, it's a bustling bazaar with a plethora of souvenir shops, traditional coffeehouses serving Arabic coffee and Hookah, and a variety of restaurants scattered all around the area.

Then you will transfer to the hotel, and overnight in Cairo hotel.

Day 3: Luxor Tour by Flight

In the morning, you'll be picked up from your hotel and transferred to Cairo Airport for your flight to Luxor.

Upon reaching Luxor Airport, our experienced tour guide will meet you to explore the west bank of Luxor. Our first destination will be the Valley of the Kings, where you can explore the ancient tombs of pharaohs from different dynasties. Next, we'll visit the magnificent <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u>, an essential site from ancient times.

Continuing our journey, you'll have the chance to see <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u>, standing as guardians at the entrance of Amenhotep's Memorial Temple in Luxor, made from quartzite.

We'll then cross the Nile River to the east bank of Luxor, where you'll marvel at the grandeur of Luxor Temple and the impressive <u>Karnak Temples</u>, dedicated to the god Amon-Ra, his wife Mut, and their son Khonso.

At the end of the day, our tour guide will accompany you to Luxor Airport for your return flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo for check-in and an overnight stay.
