<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

As you walk around the impressive monuments on the island, you'll hear captivating stories about its history.

After the show, you'll take a boat back to the harbor, and then a shuttle will bring you back to your hotel in Aswan.
