After visiting the Cairo landmarks in your <u>Egypt Trips</u>, you will be flown to Luxor to explore the ancient Luxor Temple complex situated on the east bank of the Nile River in southern Egypt. You will also have the opportunity to visit the Valley of the Kings, a burial ground on the west bank of the Nile River that houses the tombs of numerous prominent pharaohs. Additionally, you will see the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous stone statues located on the west bank of the Nile River that depict the pharaoh Amenhotep III. These statues were constructed in the 14th century BC.

Following your exploration of Luxor, you will return to Cairo and then travel by car to Hurghada. While in Hurghada, you will have the opportunity to relax and enjoy the beautiful beaches that the city is known for. You can swim, sunbathe, and take part in water sports like snorkeling and diving. Additionally, you will embark on a desert safari tour, which includes a guided excursion to explore the nearby desert and immerse yourself in the region's natural beauty and culture.

Itinerary

Day 1 :arrival in Cairo

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, one of our representatives will greet you and escort you to a private air-conditioned vehicle, which will take you to your first ancient site on the tour. As you travel to your hotel, you will be able to see some of the historical landmarks of Cairo, such as the Saladin Citadel. Our knowledgeable tour guide will provide you with information about this location.

During your full-day excursion, your first stop will be the <u>Giza Necropolis</u>, where you will have the opportunity to discover the Great Sphinx of Giza and the pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. These pyramids were once considered to be among the Seven Wonders of the World and were constructed around 2620 BC. You will also have the chance to take stunning panoramic photos of these legendary structures. The Great Sphinx of Giza was built during the reign of Chephren.

You will also have the opportunity to explore the Egyptian Museum in Cairo, which is also referred to as the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities.

The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities features a vast collection of over 120,000 items, including ancient artifacts, jewelry, mummies, and other preserved human remains. Among the museum's most renowned exhibits are the treasures of King Tutankhamun.

Following the tour, you will return to your hotel in Cairo to spend the night.

Day 2: Fly to Luxor

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel, you will be transported to Cairo's airport via a private airconditioned car, where you will catch your internal flight to Luxor.

Upon your arrival in Luxor, you will be greeted by a knowledgeable guide who will escort you in a private air-conditioned car to the east bank of the Nile River in southern Egypt. There, you will begin your journey by visiting Luxor Temple, which was originally constructed by Amenhotep III and later expanded by several other pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, Horemheb, and Ramesses II.

After visiting Luxor Temple, you will continue your tour by visiting The Valley of the Kings, which is situated on the west bank of the Nile River. The valley is an ancient burial ground that contains the tombs of numerous prominent pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, Ramses II, and Seti I. The tombs were meticulously designed to protect the pharaohs' bodies and their possessions because it was believed that they would require them in the afterlife.

After visiting The Valley of the Kings, the tour will continue to The Colossi of Memnon, two enormous stone statues located on the west bank of the Nile River. These statues, which are made of quartzite sandstone, stand over 18 meters (60 feet) tall. They are positioned at the entrance of Amenhotep III's mortuary temple, which was once among the most extensive and luxurious temples in ancient Egypt.

at the end of our tour, we will deliver you to Steigenberger Nile Palace Luxor to stay one night before heading to Hurghada.

Day 3: Heading to Hurghada

Following a delicious breakfast at your hotel, you will be transported to Hurghada in a private air-conditioned vehicle. Once you arrive, you will be staying at the Dream Beach Hotel.

You can relax on this day after our long way by taking a break at the beach or engaging in other activities there.

Day 4: Desert Safari at hurghada
