Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Cairo

After breakfast today, you'll be transferred to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to catch your flight and bid farewell to Egypt. Upon arrival at the airport, your tour guide will be waiting for you with a sign displaying your name to ensure a smooth process. You'll be transported to your hotel in Cairo in a comfortable airconditioned vehicle, where your guide will assist you with check-in and provide an overview of your 6-day itinerary for the Cairo and White Desert Adventure. If you have extra time, you can consider booking one of our tours in Cairo.

Day 2 in Cairo Tour to Saqqara and Dahshur

In the morning, your tour guide will meet you at your hotel and take you to Saqqara. Here, you'll have the opportunity to visit the first pyramid-shaped tomb constructed by ancient Egyptians, known as the StepPyramid of Saqqara. It was designed by the renowned architect Imhotep and built during the third dynasty of Egypt for King Djoser, who was the first king to have a step pyramid built for him.

This trip provides visitors with the opportunity to explore the pyramids of King Teti, the first ruler of the sixth dynasty, as well as King Teti's pyramid, which was built during the ancient kingdom. The tour also includes a visit to King Unas' pyramid, which features some of the most remarkable burial chambers of any pyramid and does not require an additional ticket.

During the tour, you'll have the opportunity to visit one of the Saqqara Mastaba Tombs of the Nobles, where you can witness various scenes depicting daily life in ancient Egypt. These scenes include a range of activities and even the many corridors of the tomb.

After having lunch at a local restaurant in Saqqara, you'll head to the <u>Memphis</u> Museum where you can see the alabaster sphinx, the second-largest sphinx statue from ancient Egypt. This magnificent statue is made from an 80-ton block of marble. Additionally, you'll also have the opportunity to see the gigantic limestone statue of King Ramses II, who was the greatest ruler and builder of the New Kingdom during the nineteenth dynasty.

The tour will conclude with a visit to <u>Dahshur Pyramids</u>, an intriguing archaeological site in ancient Egypt. Here, you'll have the opportunity to explore the pyramids of King Senfru, who founded the fourth dynasty and learn about the history of the pyramids during the Old Kingdom. The Great Pyramid and Khafra Pyramids are two of the largest pyramids in ancient Egypt, while the Red Pyramid is the tallest structure in the Dahshur Necropolis. You'll also visit the Bent Pyramid, which was the second pyramid built by Snefru and was known by the ancient Egyptians as "Sneferu is Shining in the South" or "The Southern Shining Pyramid", not the "Bent Pyramid."

You'll be returned to your accommodation in Cairo or Giza following this breathtaking trip, which you may experience as part of your Cairo or Giza day excursions.

Day3-Sultan Hassan Mosque and Madrassa

After having breakfast, your tour guide will take you to visit the Khan el-Khalili and Sultan Hassan Bazaars, along with the Salah el Din Citadel.

By taking this personalized trip, you'll gain a deeper understanding of Egypt's rich and diverse history. One of the most noteworthy attractions is the Alabaster Mosque, situated in the <u>SalaDin Citadel Egypt</u> which is perched on a limestone hill with spectacular views of Cairo. This mosque is among the most significant in the city and welcomes visitors of all faiths. It still serves as a place of worship for the Muslim community in Cairo, offering a unique opportunity to experience the country's cultural and religious traditions firsthand.

The Alabaster Mosque incorporates alabaster covering on its lower portion, both inside and outside, and the upper portion is constructed using limestone siding sourced from the Giza Pyramids.

While inside the Alabaster Mosque, your tour guide will provide you with an explanation of the basic tenets of Islam and will also translate some of the most commonly recited prayers for you.

As the tour continues to the Khan el Khalili bazaar, your guide will introduce you to the renowned markets that are said to have inspired Christopher Columbus to embark on his journey to discover the United States. You'll have some free time to explore the labyrinthine streets and try your hand at bargaining with the shopkeepers to purchase a souvenir from your trip to Egypt.

The tour will proceed to Sultan Hassan's mosque and madrassa (school), which is widely considered one of the most remarkable examples of Mamluk architecture in Cairo. This magnificent structure is believed to have been constructed between 1356 and 1363.

The mosque is also considered one of the largest in the entire Islamic world, not just in Cairo, with a length of approximately 492 feet (150 meters) and a height of 118 feet (36 meters). Its tallest minaret stands at a height of 223 feet (68 meters). As this is a personalized trip, you can decide how much time you want to spend at each location.

at the end, we will return you back to your hotel and overnight.

Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour from Cairo

After having breakfast at your hotel, you'll meet up with your certified tour guide and driver to begin your journey to the <u>Bahariya Oasis in Egypt</u> from Cairo. This will be a 4-hour trip, during which you'll get to see the salt lakes and the ancient site. Once you arrive, you'll have a private tour of the English House, where you can witness a breathtaking sunset and enjoy a magnificent panoramic view. You'll also visit the local market and explore the Bahariya Oasis area. Additionally, you'll make a stop at the stunning Crystal Mountain, where you can marvel at the crystals that sparkle like stars in the sky, as well as the volcanic rocks in the Valley of Agabat. You'll spend the night at the Bahariya Hotel after having dinner.

Day 5: White Desert tour

After enjoying a tasty home-cooked breakfast at the camp, you'll have the opportunity to go for a swim in the hot spring. Following this, you'll visit the white limestone formations that take the shape of a rabbit, mushrooms, and the Sphinx.

then we will transfer to visit Gara Cave, also known as Djara Cave, which is a fascinating cave that was created by rain corrosion into the limestone around 55 million years ago. It is close to the caravan trail that connects Farafra Oasis and Assiut. It has rocks that sparkle. The beautiful stalactites and stalagmites that were created when water melted the limestone, as well as artifacts and rock art, have all been discovered here, clearly demonstrating human presence within the cave during prehistoric times, most likely around the late Neolithic period.

Gara Cave is a highly significant destination for adventurers and explorers, attracting a large number of visitors. Egyptians, in particular, appreciate such pristine natural environments and often visit the site.

Afterward, you'll spend the night camping in <u>The White Desert in Egypt</u> a stunning natural wonder located in the Western Desert of Egypt. where you can enjoy the beautiful sounds of Bedouin music is an important aspect of the culture of the Bedouin people, who are traditionally nomadic tribes of the Middle East and North Africa, including Egypt. The music is typically performed during social gatherings, religious ceremonies, and other cultural events. while savoring a delicious meal prepared by the local guides.

Day 6: Back to Cairo
