You will stay at an Aswan hotel for 3 days and breakfast will be included.

On the last day of your trip, you will be staying at a hotel in Cairo, and breakfast will be provided.

The package includes domestic flights from Cairo to Luxor, and from Aswan to Cairo.

The entrance fees for the museums and historical sites mentioned in the itinerary are included in the package.

During all of our Egypt travel packages, you will be provided with delicious lunch meals at high-quality restaurants as specified in the itinerary.

The First Day of the itinerary involves arriving in Cairo.

When you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#), a representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you and transfer you to your hotel in Cairo for an overnight stay. They will also review your 9-day itinerary for Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel travel to ensure that all Egypt tours are scheduled as planned.

Day 2: Excursions in Cairo (Giza Pyramids - Memphis-Saqqara)

Following breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your private tour guide and proceed to visit one of the world's most magnificent sites, the Pyramids of Giza (Cheops, Chephren, Mycerinus) and The Great Sphinx. Here, you will witness the incredible architectural feats achieved by the ancient pharaohs of Egypt and even have the opportunity to [camel ride tours in the Giza pyramids](#). Additionally, you can explore the Valley Temple of Khafra.

After enjoying lunch at a local restaurant, you will continue the tour by visiting another extraordinary site called Memphis. It served as the capital of the ancient Egyptian empire during the old kingdom and is situated to the south of the Nile Delta. You will have the opportunity to witness the colossal statue of Ramses II and other fascinating artifacts such as the Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis. Later, you will head to visit the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, an impressive monument that includes magnificent tombs of the nobles, including the tomb of Kagemni, which features remarkable scenes of ancient Egyptian art. After the Giza Pyramids tour is complete, you will return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3: Excursion in Cairo - (Cairo Citadel - Old Cairo - the Egyptian Museum)

After having breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your English-speaking Egyptologist guide who will accompany you in a private car to visit [the Egyptian Museum in Cairo](#). The museum is a historical landmark that houses numerous magnificent monuments and historical treasures. You will then enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Later, you will discover Islamic Cairo through a visit to the Saladin Citadel, built by Salah El Din Al-Ayoubi, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was constructed following the Turkish style of architecture in 1805 A.D. and is similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey. Additionally, you will visit Old Cairo, where the Coptic neighborhood is located, and see the Church of the Holy Virgin Mary (known as the Hanging

Church), the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and the cavern church of St. Sergius. After the Cairo day tours are complete, you will be transferred to your Cairo hotel.

Day 4: Arrive at Luxor (The East Bank Tours)

After having breakfast and checking out from your Cairo hotel, you will meet a representative who will transfer you to Cairo Airport for your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival in Luxor, your guide will transfer you to your hotel and assist you with the check-in process. In the afternoon, you will embark on the Luxor East Bank tour of the Nile, where you will visit [the Temple of Karnak facts](#) and the Temple of Luxor, which are connected by an avenue of sphinxes. You will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 5: (The West Bank Tours)

After having breakfast, your tour guide will pick you up from your Luxor hotel, and you will meet a representative who will transfer you to the West Bank of Luxor for tours. The tour includes visiting some remarkable places such as the [Colossi of Memnon](#) and the Temple of Hatshepsut. Hatshepsut was one of the female pharaohs who rose to power in ancient Egypt during the 18th dynasty of the new kingdom. You will also visit the [Valley of the Kings in Luxor](#), where the ancient Egyptians buried the kings from the 17th dynasty to the 20th dynasty in tombs and cemeteries carved out of the mountain rock. You will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (Unfinished Obelisk - High Dam)

After having breakfast, you will be transferred to Aswan by an air-conditioned car in the morning. Upon arrival, your guide will transfer you to your hotel. In the afternoon, your tour guide will accompany you to visit [the High Dam in Aswan](#), a crucial project in Egypt that helps control floods on the banks of the Nile, and [the Unfinished Obelisk](#). You will take a break for lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel for accommodation in Aswan.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

After having breakfast, you will continue your tours in Aswan and visit the [Philae Temple](#), which was built in the Greco-Roman style and dedicated to the worship of the goddess Isis. The temple is one of the four places where the legend of Isis, Osiris, and Horus took place.

A lunch break at a local restaurant. Then. You will return to the hotel and accommodation in Aswan.

At night, you will have the opportunity to enjoy one of the most astounding things to do in Aswan by watching the Philae Temple Sound and Light Show. You will be transferred to the dock to take a motorboat on the River Nile that leads to the island where the show takes place. The show will take you on a detailed journey to learn more about ancient Egyptian history and the legend of the goddess Isis, the god Osiris, and their son and protector of kingship, the god Horus. The show will also showcase the interesting myth of Isis and Osiris related to the temple and the Island of Philae.

The annual flooding of the Nile River posed a threat to the Philae Temple site, which was almost submerged for six months each year. A significant campaign was undertaken in the mid-20th century to rescue the temple from vanishing due to excessive flooding. The temple was relocated to a higher ground level on Agilika Island, where it stands today. During the Philae Temple Sound and Light Show, you can enjoy magnificent laser presentations that showcase the glory and majesty of the historical site. You can also walk through the magnificent monuments of the island while listening to narrations of its history.

After watching the Philae Temple Sound and Light Show, you will take a boat ride back to the harbor, and from there, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Aswan.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

After having breakfast at the hotel, you will travel to [Abu Simbel Temples](#) with a representative in a private air-conditioned vehicle. The tour will include a visit to the Temples of Ramses II at Abu Simbel. Later, you will return to Aswan and transfer to the Aswan airport to catch your flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival, you will check in and spend the night at your Cairo hotel.

Day 9: Final Departure

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you will meet with a representative who will accompany you to Cairo International Airport for your final flight back home. We hope you had a wonderful experience during your 9-day travels in Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel.
