And begin your exploration with a visit to the Temple of Hibis. This well-preserved ancient temple dates back to the 6th century BC and is dedicated to the god Amun. Admire the intricate carvings and hieroglyphs that adorn the temple walls, and learn about its historical significance.

Day 7: Kharga \ Luxor (East Bank).

Upon you arrive to luxor begin your day by visiting Karnak Temple, one of the largest temple complexes in the world. It was dedicated to the god Amun-Ra and covers an area of approximately 200 acres. Explore its vast hypostyle hall, obelisks, sacred lake, and other stunning architectural features.

Then take a break from the outdoor sites and immerse yourself in the treasures of the Luxor Museum. This museum showcases a collection of artifacts from Luxor's temples and necropolises, including statues, reliefs, jewelry, and the intact mummy of a pharaoh.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank.

Begin your day with a special breakfast, then start your day by visiting the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of many pharaohs, including Tutankhamun. Explore the elaborate tombs carved into the cliffs and discover the intricate wall paintings and hieroglyphics that adorn the chambers.

Then take a break from the archaeological sites and enjoy a traditional Egyptian lunch at a local restaurant.

Next, visit the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues that once guarded the entrance of a mortuary temple. These imposing statues depict Pharaoh Amenhotep III and provide a great photo opportunity.

Day 9: Edfu / Kom Ombo.

Start your day by visiting the Edfu Temple allows you to explore the intricate carvings that depict various religious scenes, including the mythical battles between Horus and his uncle Seth. The temple offers a remarkable insight into the religious beliefs and rituals of ancient Egypt.

After that head to the Kom Ombo Temple is situated on the banks of the Nile River and consists of two identical temple sections, one dedicated to Sobek and the other to Horus. The temple was constructed during the Ptolemaic period, between the 2nd century BC and the 1st century AD.

Day 10: Aswan Sightseeing.

Get your fresh breakfast and let's start the day by visiting the beautiful Philae Temple. Located on an island in the Nile River, it is dedicated to the goddess Isis. You can reach the temple by a short boat ride, and once there, marvel at the well-preserved structures and intricate carvings depicting ancient Egyptian mythology.

Finally, end your day with a relaxing felucca boat ride on the Nile River. Sail around the islands of Aswan, soak in the serene ambiance, and enjoy breathtaking views of the city and its surroundings.

Day 11: Disembarkation / Cairo.

After your last breakfast in Aswan prepare yourself to return to Cairo by the sleepy train and enjoy with surrounding views.

Day 12: Arrive Cairo.
