Day 1: Arrival Cairo-Check-in.

Following your arrival our representative will help you to check in at the hotel, Then you can have a relaxing time on your journey.

Day 2: Giza pyramids, sphinx and Sakkara tour.

After breakfast, we start our trip with the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mycerinus). These structures were built as tombs for the pharaohs during the Old Kingdom period.

Then, the Great Sphinx of Giza is an iconic symbol of ancient Egypt. This mythical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a human is believed to represent the pharaoh Khafre. It stands tall as a guardian of the Giza Plateau. Visitors can admire its massive size and intricate details while learning about its historical significance from the surrounding information boards.

Finally, go to Saqqara, designed by the famous architect Imhotep, the Step Pyramid is a significant architectural achievement and marks the evolution from mastaba tombs to pyramid structures.

Day 3: Cairo Sightseeing tour.

Following breakfast then let's go to the Egyptian museum, This museum is home to an extensive collection of artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun. Explore the various exhibits and learn about ancient Egyptian history, art, and culture.

And after this take a tour of Islamic Cairo, a historic district with beautiful mosques, ancient streets, and vibrant markets. Visit landmarks such as the Citadel of Saladin, home to the magnificent Muhammad Ali Mosque. Explore the historic Khan El Khalili Bazaar, where you can shop for traditional crafts, spices, and souvenirs.

Day 4: Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation to Myfair Nile cruise.

Start your day by taking an early morning flight from Cairo to Aswan.

Upon arrival in Aswan, head straight to the Aswan High Dam, one of the most significant engineering achievements in Egypt. Explore the dam and learn about its impact on the region's economy and agriculture.

Then head to an amazing Myfair Nile cruise.

Day 5: Aswan Tours/Kom Ombo.

Arrive in Aswan and check into your hotel.

Then you can take a felucca ride on the Nile River, enjoying the scenic views and the gentle breeze.

After that head to Kom Ombo Temple, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Horus. This unique temple is divided into two symmetrical parts.

Day 6: Sightseeing Edfu temple.

After taking your breakfast let's explore Edfu temple,

It is one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt and offers a glimpse into ancient Egyptian religious practices.

Finally, you can have lunch in a local restaurant.

Day 7: Luxor East and west Bank tour to Hurghada.

After having your breakfast get ready to transfer to Luxor's West Bank. Visit the Valley of the Kings, where many pharaohs, including Tutankhamun, were buried. Explore the elaborate tombs and learn about the fascinating history of ancient Egyptian burial practices.

You can also visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and explore the Colossi of Memnon, two massive statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III that once guarded his mortuary temple.

And at the end go to the airport to transfer to Hurghada.

Day 8: Free day at Hurghada.

After your arrival, you can spend some time in your hotel relaxing and enjoy with your meals.

Day 9: Free day at Hurghada.

You can visit the Hurghada Marina, a vibrant waterfront promenade with restaurants, cafes, shops, and entertainment options. Take a leisurely stroll, enjoy a meal with a view, or go shopping for souvenirs.
