Itinerary

Day 1: Tower to Pyramids of Giza, The Egyptian museum and old Cairo.

After your breakfast Start your day by visiting the Pyramids of Giza, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. These magnificent structures include the Great Pyramid of Khufu (Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mycerinus).

After the Pyramids, head to the Egyptian Museum in Cairo. This museum houses an extensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun's tomb. You can admire the stunning exhibits, such as statues, jewelry, mummies, and the famous golden mask of Tutankhamun.

Next, proceed to Old Cairo, also known as Coptic Cairo or Masr al-Qadima. This area is home to several historical landmarks, religious sites, and cultural attractions. The next place is White Desert, Once you reach the White Desert, you can Explore the unique limestone formations, known as "mushroom rocks" or "inselbergs," which have been sculpted by wind erosion over thousands of years. Take your time to wander through this otherworldly landscape, capturing breathtaking photos and enjoying the tranquility of the desert.

Day 3: Cairo to Alexandria.

These ancient underground tombs are a fascinating blend of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman architectural styles, explore the Qaitbay Citadel Next, make your way to the Qaitbay Citadel, This fortress was built in the 15th century by Sultan Qaitbay and offers panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea. Take a stroll along the fort's walls, and visit the naval museum inside.

End your day in Alexandria with a visit to the Roman Amphitheater, This well-preserved ancient theater dates back to the 4th century and once hosted various performances and events. Marvel at the architecture and imagine the grand spectacles that took place here centuries ago.
