<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival at Cairo - Check-in

Once your flight lands at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you with a signboard displaying your name. They will then drive you to your hotel in a specially designed air-conditioned vehicle for check-in and overnight after reviewing your itinerary to make sure all of the sightseeing tours in Cairo are scheduled in accordance with the permitted schedule.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis, Quad Biking in Giza

After your breakfast, start your day with the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> tour takes you to the Giza necropolis, where you will witness the Great Pyramid of <u>King Cheops</u>, the only remaining wonder of the 7 wonders of the ancient world. This massive structure, established 4500 years ago, stands at a height of 146 meters and 230 meters long for each side. The tour continues to the high plateau, where you can see the three pyramids, including the pyramid of King Chephren and King Mycerinus, with the queen's pyramids beside the smallest pyramid.

The Bedouin guide will take amazing photos while you enjoy a camel ride around the Giza Pyramids. The majestic <u>Sphinx</u> of Giza, part of the pyramid complex of King Chephren, is believed to be built for the king himself, symbolizing his power as a lion and genius as a human. The Valley Temple of Chephren is also located near the sphinx, where the mummification of the royal body took place during funeral rituals.

After lunch, you will visit <u>Saqqara</u>, the necropolis of an earlier period 200 years before the great kings who built the 3 pyramids in Giza. You will see the first-ever stone pyramid, the Step Pyramid, and the tomb of King Teti, who ruled Egypt during the 6th dynasty.

Finally, you can try the adventurous quad biking tour in the Giza Pyramids, followed by a night at a hotel.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Nile Cruise Dinner

After breakfast, the Cairo city tour begins with a visit to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, a 2 hour tour in Tahrir Square filled with over 120,000 artifacts from different epochs. The museum features statues of kings, deities, sarcophagi, jewelry, daily life accessories, and mummies. The tour also includes a visit to King Tutankhamen's golden collection found in his tomb.

Take your lunch and the tour continues to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, visiting the Roman Fortress of Babylon, the Cavern Church of St. Serius, and the oldest Synagogue of Ben Ezra, which was once a Christian Church but was sold to a Jewish wealthy man named Ben Ezra.

At the end of your day, the tour leader takes you on a dinner cruise on the Nile, where you can enjoy Egyptian cuisine buffet dinner, belly dancing, and Tanoura dance show. You will return to the hotel overnight.

Meals include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Final Departure

After enjoying your morning meal at your Cairo hotel on the final day of your Cairo City Breaks, you will meet our representative who will drive you to the international airport in Cairo so you can catch your journey home.
