### Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Nile Cruise Dinner

When you land at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from our company will be waiting to greet you and drive you to your hotel in Cairo where they will help you with check-in.

This evening, an optional Cairo Nile dinner cruise is offered, allowing you to enjoy a delicious dinner buffet while cruising the Nile River on a boat for an hour. A pleasant oriental show (belly dancing) and Tanoura dance performance will keep you entertained while you dine on the Nile in Cairo.

## Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

Your tour guide will meet you today after you finish your open-buffet breakfast at the hotel and accompany you on your day trip from Cairo to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, Dahshur, and Memphis.

Your Cairo day tours should begin with a visit to the Giza Pyramids, where you will be astounded by their size. These enormous structures were built during the <u>Old Kingdom</u> of Ancient Egypt history by the most powerful kings and rulers as evidence of the success they attained 4500 years ago thanks to the Nile River.

See the Great Pyramid of King Cheops. King <u>Cheops</u> (Khufu in ancient Egyptian) built his pyramid using more than 2.3 million limestone blocks to serve as his eternal home from which he would ascend to heaven. The structure stood at a height of 146 meters with 230 meters long for each side. King Cheops was influenced by his father's attempts to build enormous burial tombs.

passing by the high plateau to admire the three magnificent pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Chephren, the son of Cheops, built his 136-meter-tall pyramid while leaving some of the outer casing in place as a small tribute to his paternal figure.

Visit <u>the Great Sphinx of Giza</u>, a statue of a lion with a human head that is believed to have been created by King Chephren himself because it is located within his pyramid complex, and go inside the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial ritual.

Travel to Memphis, an ancient city that is now known as Mit Rahina, to continue your sightseeing in Cairo. You can visit the open-air museum here, which is home to the second-largest alabaster sphinx and a sizable statue of King Ramses II, who served as the new kingdom's most powerful tyrant.

Transfer to the Dahshur Archaeological Site to see the Red and Bent Pyramids, two of the four pyramids built for King Snefru, the 4th dynasty's founder and King Cheops' father. One of the most unusual pyramids in Egypt is the Bent Pyramid, which still has a significant amount of the outer casing material. The reddish color of the limestone blocks used to build <u>The Red Pyramid</u> helped to identify it, and it is regarded as the first perfectly shaped pyramid in Egyptian history.

You will have a gourmet lunch in a good-quality restaurant overlooking the pyramids of Giza before being transferred back to your hotel.

# Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

After breakfast, take a flight from Cairo to Hurghada. You will be met by one of our representatives at <u>Hurghada International Airport</u>, who will drive you to the hotel and help you check in. The rest of the day can be spent lazing by the pool and enjoying the evening show, or you can opt to go on one of our other Hurghada excursions or an optional Jeep Bedouin Safari at sunset.

## Day 4: Snorkeling Trip to Mahmya Island By Boat

Today you will enjoy a boat snorkeling tour to the Mahmya Islands from Hurghada. The tour begins after your guide transfers you to the location where you will board the boat and sail with designated stops for the best snorkeling and swimming experiences at one of the best naturally protected areas with a wide variety of fish and coral reefs. Once you've finished your boat ride to Mahmya Island for snorkeling, take a transfer back to the hotel.

### Day 5: Fly to Cairo, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El-Khalili

After a delicious buffet breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport to board your flight to Cairo. Once there, you will be met by your guide and transferred to the city's oldest district for an educational Coptic Cairo tour. You will see <u>The Hanging Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was constructed above the ruins of Babylon's Roman fortress, the Church of St. Sergius, also known as the cavern church, which houses the well where the holy family drank their water, and other important Coptic Cairo.

Enjoy your lunch at a top-notch restaurant. After that, we'll continue our Cairo day tours with an <u>Egyptian Museum</u> tour, where we'll see the most ancient artifacts in Cairo's Egyptian Museum, which was first made available to the public in 1902 to house the largest collection of prehistoric artifacts.

Finally, you will be taken to the <u>Khan El Khalili Bazaar</u>, which is Cairo's oldest market, for an unforgettable shopping experience.

To check in and spend the night in Cairo, you will be driven to the hotel.

#### Day 6: Final Departure, Optional Saqqara Tour with Camel Ride

After enjoying your delicious final breakfast in Egypt, you will be taken to the Cairo airport for your final departure. You can reserve our Saqqara from Cairo day trip if you have enough time left over from your 6 Days Cairo and Hurghada Tour Package before your flight. to see the first stone pyramid ever built, which was constructed about 200 years before the great Cheops pyramid in Giza.
