#### Day 1: Arrival day

When your plane lands at Cairo International Airport, a Cairo Top Tours representative will greet and assist you. Our tour leader will transfer you to Siwa Oasis in a private and air-conditioned vehicle. He will help you with the check-in procedures at Siwa Oasis Hotel or a similar hotel.

### Day 2: Sightseeing tour in Siwa

At the Eco-lodge, start your <u>Siwa Oasis tours</u> with a delicious breakfast. While you're there, check out the remains of the Shali Fortress to discover how the ancient Siwan people fled from the threat of outside attacks. After that, you will be shown Aghurmi Village, where you will see the 26th Dynasty Temple of The Oracle, the Temple of Um Ubeyda, and another temple honoring Amun Ra. Lunch will be served at one of the Oasis's restaurants while you learn more about the distinctive Siwan legacy during your tour of the Siwa House Museum.

After seeing the Shali Fort and using some of your free time for <u>shopping</u>, head to the conical Mountain of the Dead, which is a little over a kilometer to the north of Shali. Gebel Al-Mawta has four tombs that are well worth seeing. These 26th Dynasty, Roman, and Ptolemaic monuments are etched into the rock.

Cleopatra Springs was named after Queen Cleopatra, the last female pharaoh to rule Egypt. Recording: It is rumored that Queen Cleopatra enjoyed relaxing in these beautiful, pure springs. Before being driven to Fitnas Island to see the magnificent sunset, enjoy swimming and diving into the shimmering water.

#### Day 3: Safari Tour across the Great Sand Sea

The hotel will serve you a substantial breakfast before you set out on your <u>Siwa Oasis Desert</u> Safari. Following that, your licensed Egyptologist will take you on a 4x4 tour around the Great Sand Sea. Before moving on to the stunning dunes and the fossilized corals from the Cambrian era, we will start our Egypt Desert Safari tour by visiting the Mountain of the Dead and the tombs of several of the kings in the oasis. Then, after taking you to one of the Great Sand Sea's magnificent sites, which is a

gorgeous lake in the heart of the desert, you could be fortunate enough to see flamingo birds enjoying the peace of the desert while taking a relaxing bath.

After going by Dakrour Mountain, we will now enjoy sandboarding, which gives us the thrill of tumbling down dunes as opposed to snow. After a day of skiing, the Bir Wahid hot spring is the ideal spot to relax. After the Great Sand Sea Tour, we'll sip Bedouin tea amid the dunes and take in a second breathtaking sunset. After that, return to the eco-lodge and spend the night there.

### **Day 4: Returning to Cairo**

Early in the morning, you will savor your breakfast box before departing from <u>Siwa Oasis</u> and making your way to Cairo via Marsa Matrouh. You will be driven to your overnight hotel in Cairo upon arrival. Should our return to Cairo transpire earlier than anticipated, you may opt to reserve an evening activity in Cairo, like taking in a belly dance or Tanoura dance show while dining on an optionally thrilling Nile cruise aboard a sailing boat on the Nile River.

#### Day 5: Tour to Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum

After your breakfast at your hotel, a tour leader from our company will meet you in the lobby to assist you during your day trips around Cairo. Your tour will start with an exhilarating visit to <a href="the Giza">the Giza</a>
<a href="Pyramids">Pyramids</a>, where you will be astounded by the enormity of these enormous monuments built by the greatest kings and rulers of ancient Egypt's kingdom.

See the Great Pyramid of Cheops, which is the model for the laborious construction of large burial chambers. You will also see the two enormous pyramids at Dahshur, which belong to King Snefru, who was the founder of the 4th dynasty. After that, head to the high plateau for a stunning view of the three pyramids, which include the pyramids of Chephren, the son of Cheops and the heir to King Djedefre. His pyramid was somewhat more compact.

It is now possible to see the <u>Great Sphinx at Giza</u>, a figure of a man with a lion's body that is thought to have been created for King Chephren himself because it is located within his funeral complex. You can book an optional camel ride on the plateau surrounding the Giza Pyramids. Next, you will visit the Valley of Temples, where the monarch was first mummified and then interred.

You will continue your exploration of Cairo by seeing the world's largest collection of Egyptian artifacts at the Egyptian Museum. Enjoy a classy lunch at a restaurant before being driven to the Khan El Khalili Bazaar for a close-up look at the locals and one of Cairo's best walking tours. After your Cairo City Tour is over, you'll be taken back to your hotel for the night.
