#### **Itinerary**

## Day 1: Arriving To Cairo,

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> for the 5-day Cairo and Luxor Easter tour, our tour leader will warmly welcome you and aid you with your luggage. You'll then be transported to your Cairo hotel, where a refreshing welcome drink awaits.

Our tour leader will go over your itinerary, ensuring all is on track and addressing any queries about your Egypt day tours. They'll also assist with seamless hotel check-in, ensuring your comfort and a smooth settling process.

## Day 2: Egypt Pyramids Tours.

Your first day in Cairo starts with a visit to the remarkable Giza Pyramids. Accompanied by your guide, you'll discover the impressive structures crafted by ancient Egyptian kings from the 4th dynasty, such as the renowned pyramids of Cheops, <u>Chephren</u>, and Mycerinus. Learn about their historical importance as burial sites for these revered rulers.

For an optional experience, you can choose to ride camels in Giza and snap memorable photos with the help of a Bedouin guide. You'll also see the iconic <u>Great Sphinx</u> and the Valley Temple, both part of King Chephren's burial complex.

Following that, your driver will take you to <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, where you'll encounter the oldest stone pyramid in Egypt – the Step Pyramid. This pyramid, designed by the famous architect Imhotep for King Djoser of the 3rd dynasty, showcases a unique phase in the evolution of royal tombs.

You'll also have the chance to explore the <u>Pyramid of Teti</u> and the tomb of Kagemni, his son-in-law. Notable for its lavish offerings and hunting scenes depicted on its walls, Kagemni's tomb is one of the grandest noble tombs.

After your day's adventures, a delectable lunch awaits at an Egyptian restaurant. Later, you'll head to <u>Memphis</u>, now called Mit Rahina, to see the open-air museum housing impressive artifacts like the alabaster sphinx of Memphis and the colossal statue of Ramses II. At day's end, you'll be taken back to your hotel.

This day's activities include breakfast and lunch.

### Day 3: Fly to Luxor's East Bank Tour

Day 3 takes you to Luxor from Cairo by flight, arranged by our representative. Upon Luxor's arrival, your personal tour guide will warmly greet you and guide you throughout your two-day Luxor exploration.

Your Luxor adventure starts on the east bank with a visit to Luxor Temple, an impressive creation by

King Amenhotep III, later enhanced by various rulers. This temple stands as a remarkable testament to Egypt's ancient civilization and religious significance.

Next, the <u>Temple of Karnak</u> awaits, which was once the core of the new kingdom's religion and governance. Built over epochs by multiple pharaohs, it's the world's largest temple. You'll enter via the sphinx-lined avenue, and your guide will share captivating historical and cultural insights.

Lunch at a local restaurant follows your tours, and then you'll settle into your hotel. This day includes breakfast and lunch.

# Day 4: Luxor West Bank Trips, Fly Back To Cairo

On day 4 of your package explore remarkable monuments. Led by your guide, you'll explore this area, starting with the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, which was a new kingdom necropolis with over 63 royal tombs concealed in the hills. Among them, King Tutankhamun's intact tomb stands out as a highlight.

Then, you'll visit the Mortuary Temple of El Deir El Bahari, built by architect Senmout for <u>Queen</u> <u>Hatshepsut</u> This temple, also called the Northern Monastery, is an impressive testament to her powerful rule marked by significant reforms.

Afterward, you'll head back to Luxor Airport via private transfer for a flight to Cairo. Once back, our representative will greet you and take you to your hotel for check-in. Breakfast and lunch are provided

## Day 5: Cairo Tour, Final Departure

On your last day in Egypt, you'll begin by exploring the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo. Your driver will take you to downtown Cairo, where you'll find a 19th-century building filled with fascinating artifacts from the Pharaonic era. You'll marvel at King Tutankhamun's golden treasures, like jewelry, chariots, and his famous golden mask.

Next, venture to Old Cairo for a glimpse of its ancient Christian churches, including the <u>Hanging</u> <u>Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary. This church stands atop the remains of the Roman fortress Babylon. Explore sacred icons and relics, and visit the crypt where the Holy Virgin Mary and baby Jesus found refuge. You'll also see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, once a Coptic Church sold during Islamic Cairo's taxing times.

Following your tours, savor a delightful Egyptian cuisine lunch before heading to <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, the old market. Here, enjoy the charm of Islamic Cairo, shop for memorable souvenirs, and immerse yourself in the local atmosphere.
