Itinerary

Day 1: Friday - Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

When you arrive at Aswan Airport, our agent will greet and assist you. You will then board your Egypt Nile Cruise and have lunch before your Aswan tours. Following lunch, you will start your Aswan day tours with our tour guide, visiting the <u>High Dam</u>, the construction of which was made possible by the Soviet Union in the 1960s to protect Egypt from the yearly floods caused by the Nile.

During the Aswan excursions, you will also see <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was constructed in honor of Goddess Isis, the goddess of magic in ancient Egyptian religion. Built in the Greco-Roman style, the temple overlooks the Nile River and is considered one of the most beautiful temples in Egypt. After a tiring day of Aswan excursions, we will return to the Nile Cruise boat where you can unwind with afternoon tea and the captain's welcome cocktail. After supper, you will continue to witness Nubian entertainment on board the ship.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Saturday - Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on board the MS Esplanade Nile Cruise, your Egyptologist guide will meet you in the lobby to take you on a tour of the amazing <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which was constructed during the Ptolemaic era in honor of the two local gods, Sobek, the crocodile, and Haroeris, the falcon-god of Kom Ombo. After exploring the Temple, you will continue your journey directly to Edfu. After enjoying your delectable lunch on board, you will travel to <u>Edfu</u> to see the Horus Temple. Horus is the son of Osiris and the protector of kingship. After your Egypt Day Tours are over, you will prepare to sail to Esna to attend an Egyptian Galabeya Party. You will spend the night in Esna and get ready for tomorrow's Luxor excursions.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

You will have Breakfast aboard the boat, then your comfortable MS Esplanade Nile After lunch on board and some downtime with afternoon tea, the ship will go towards Luxor via the Esna Lock. From there, you may continue your Luxor day tours to see the <u>Luxor Temple</u>. The venerable Pharaoh Amenophis the Third constructed the temple, which was the center of the yearly Opet Festival, one of the most important religious celebrations in ancient Egypt and devoted to Amun, Mut, and Khonsu.

During this celebration, the Amun cult sculptures. Return to Luxor East Bank Tours to see the <u>Karnak</u> <u>Temples</u>, which honor the Triad of Thebes, which was led by the Sun God Amun-Re, the Cat Goddes Mut, their consort, and their son, the Egyptian moon god Khonso. Following your Luxor Sightseeing excursions, you will dine on board the Nile Cruise and enjoy a belly dance performance.

Overnight in Luxor

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Monday - Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours

Breakfast is served on board the Egypt Nile Cruise. Following breakfast, you will check off the cruise to continue your Luxor excursions and see the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u>, one of Egypt's most important tourist destinations from ancient times. We will also take you to view the well-known Queen Hatshepsut Temple, which was designed by the brilliant architect Senmot and has been a royal burial complex for around 500 years (El-Deir El-Bahari Temple).

You will stop to visit the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, two massive colossal sculptures created for King Amenhotep III, the father of Akhenaten, after your Luxor West Bank Tours. The statues were placed within a temple that formerly stood.

After that, you'll be taken to the train or airport in Luxor.
