Day 1: (Saturday)Luxor East Bank Tours

Luxor is located 700 kilometers south of Cairo. After picking you up from the airport and assisting you there, our representative will take you to the Egypt Nile River Cruise and begin your Egypt Travel Packages with your expert tour guide to enjoy Luxor East Bank Tours. You will recognize him because he will be holding a signboard with your names on it.

The almost 500,000-person city primarily relies on agriculture and tourism. See the amazing [Karnak Temple](#), the biggest temple in Egypt. Constructed over 2000 years, it began as a modest shrine in the Middle Kingdom and expanded throughout the New Kingdom to become a massive temple that spans a vast area dedicated to the worship of Amun-Re, the Lord of All the Gods of Ancient Egypt. After that, you'll be taken to [the magnificent Luxor Temple](#), which is situated in the city bearing his name and was found in 1884 on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. Here, you can continue your sightseeing tours of Luxor.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 2: (Sunday) Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise before beginning your Luxor day tours. First, you'll visit [the magnificent El-Deir El-Bahari Temple](#), home to Queen Hatshepsut, during Luxor excursions. Here, you'll learn about the greatness and power of this powerful woman, who oversaw an empire that stretched to Mesopotamia and led military expeditions outside of Egypt. [The Valley of the Kings](#) is one of the most fascinating sites in the world, and it is here that most of the kings and rulers of Egypt during the new kingdom are resting in peace. You are about to see the enormous statues of Amenhotep III, also referred to as [the Colossi of Memnon](#). Nearby once stood a magnificent temple constructed during his rule. Sail to Edfu with pleasure on your Nile cruise ship.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3: (Monday) Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

The excursion to Edfu will begin at 8:00 AM with your Egyptologist guide accompanying you. [Edfu](#) is a gorgeous temple that is home to the falcon god Horus, who is revered as the king of heaven and is said to be the focus of a cult. You will then head back to the boat and set sail for Kom Ombo at 10:30 AM, when the excursion comes to an end.

Visit [the Kom Ombo temples](#) around 7:00 PM, and then set sail for Aswan. Aswan is well-known for being the starting point for trips to the Temple of Abu Simbel, but having fewer attractions than Luxor.

Overnight aboard the cruise boat in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: (Tuesday) Aswan Excursions

After breakfast, begin your Aswan day tours and see [the High Dam](#), which made it possible to develop in previously inundated areas of Egypt each year when the Nile flooded the country, [the Unfinished Obelisk](#),

which is believed to have been carved by [Queen Hatshepsut](#) during the new kingdom but was left unfinished due to Hatshepsut's death, and continue your Aswan excursions to [the Temple of Philae](#), which was constructed in the afternoon to honor the Goddess Isis on [the Island of Agilika](#), between the old and the new Aswan Dam. In the evening, you will be taken to see the Aswan islands by Felucca, where you will have dinner and spend the night on the boat.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: (Wednesday) Disembarkation

After breakfast on the final day of your Egypt Nile cruise tours, you will check out of your Al Kahila Nile Cruise Luxor and head to Aswan. After that, proceed to any desired Aswan drop-off spot.
