## Day 1: Saturday - Embarkation Luxor East Bank Tours

We will pick you up from any point in Luxor, such as the train station or the international airport, and the first day will be spent checking into your cozy cabin aboard the Sonesta Moon Goddess Nile Cruise before lunch. Then, enjoy your Luxor day trip with your Egyptologist guide as you see the magnificent Karnak Temple, which is regarded as the crown jewel of the ancient Egyptian temples constructed mostly during the New Kingdom. He will also lead you to the renowned Luxor Temple in Luxor, which was started by Amenhotep the Third and built by many rulers. You will take part in the Belly Dancing Show and afternoon tea after finishing your Luxor East Bank Tours before supper is served on board.

#### Day 2: Sunday - Luxor West Bank Tours - Sail o Edfu

Take an optional hot air balloon flight in Luxor early in the morning to get a bird's-eye view of the stunning city.

You will begin your Egypt Day Tours in Luxor with an early wake-up call. After breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will see the final stages of the royal tombs, which were carved into the western mountain that would later be known as the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u> by the Pharaohs of the new kingdom. You will also learn about mummification and the various Egyptian burial customs.

Proceed with your Luxor excursions, following your guide to the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and the temple of the legendary female Pharaoh from ancient Egyptian history.

Or the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. After lunch on board and an afternoon tea, set sail for Edfu. Supper is served in the lounge while music is played.

# Day 3: Monday - Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Aswan

A delicious breakfast and an early wake-up call await you on the cruise ship. After a fantastic tour of Edfu and Kom Ombo, where you can see the Edfu Temple, which was constructed for the worship of the god Horus, you sail to Kom Ombo while lunch is provided on board. Enjoy a fascinating tour of the Kom Ombo Temple, which was formerly home to the gods Sobek and Horaeris. Then, continue sailing toward Aswan while savoring a delectable afternoon tea and supper aboard. The Galabiya Party will take place as part of Cairo Top Tours' entertainment program.

## **Day 4: Tuesday - Aswan Tours**

You will have breakfast on board the boat at seven in the morning before disembarking from your Egypt Nile River Cruise and beginning your day trip to Aswan. You will explore the High Dam, which is the largest dam in Egypt, albeit not the first. After that, you will go to the Granite Quarries to see <a href="https://documents.org/linearing-to-see">The Unfinished Obelisk in Aswan</a>, which, contrary to what some scholars claim, was never completed before Queen Hatshepsut died. The <a href="https://documents.org/linearing-to-see">Philae Temple</a> in Aswan, which was built in the Greco-Roman architectural style for the worship of Goddess Isis, will be your next destination on your Aswan tours.

## **Day 5: Wednesday - Disembarkation**

Our tour guide will transport you to the Aswan train or airport, or any other desired drop-off point, following your breakfast on board the Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise boat.
