Day 1: Arrive to Luxor - Check-in - East Bank Tours

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Excursions - Sail to Esna

After a sumptuous breakfast on board the Nile cruise, our guide will be waiting for you in the lobby to start your daily sightseeing tours of Luxor. <u>The Luxor West Bank Tour</u>, one of the most significant sites in Egypt that is also recognized by UNESCO, will be covered by today's excursion.

Visit <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, the vast necropolis of millions of years of pharaohs, which is located on the ancient site of Thebes, the capital of Ancient Egypt, and has 63 magnificent royal tombs. The Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the second historically verified female pharaoh, will be your next stop. This mortuary temple is home to <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u> in addition to <u>Amon-Ra</u>, the sun god. After a fine dinner served on board, spend the afternoon celebrating and having fun as you sail to Esna.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 3: Edfu Temple - Kom Ombo Temple and arrival to from Luxor to Aswan

On the third day of your Egypt Christmas Tours, visit <u>Edfu Temple</u> after taking your tasty breakfast.

This temple, one of the most impressive and comprehensive ancient Egyptian temples, is used to worship the god Horus. The architectural and decorative elements of the temple have endured so well because they were buried beneath layers of settlement trash for millennia.

The Nile cruise will then depart for Kom Ombo, where you will meet your personal guide in the lobby and begin walking to the magnificent <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is dedicated to <u>Sobek</u>, the crocodile god, and Horaeris, the falcon-headed god. After returning to the cruise ship for a hearty lunch, the Nile cruise will depart for Aswan. After a delicious meal in the main restaurant, enjoy the evening's entertainment.

Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

While sailing to Aswan, enjoy a delicious breakfast before visiting the High Dam, which was constructed there to block the Nile and generate electricity for Egypt. After that, stop by the Unfinished Obelisk before taking a motorboat ride to Phiale, which has long captured the attention of visitors to Egypt. It was referred to as the "Pearl of Egypt" and was renowned for its beauty. Visit the Philae Temple, which was constructed in honor of the goddess Isis, as you continue your Aswan day tour. Overnight in Aswan, take in a folkloric performance and dinner.
