Day 1: Embarkation- East Bank sightseeing Tour

Your first stop will be the awe-inspiring Karnak Temple, which is an architectural marvel dedicated to <u>Amun-Ra</u>. Marvel at the grandeur and intricate details of this sacred site. you will visit the splendid <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which is a testament to the grandeur of the New Kingdom era. This iconic temple, which is located on the East Bank of the timeless Nile River, stands as a symbol of power and devotion.

Enjoy your first night's dinner on board your Nile cruise ship with the breathtaking views and a very entertaining folkloric performance.

Day 2: West Bank Tours (Valley of the kings and queens)

You can join our optional early-morning <u>hot air balloon ride</u> in Luxor if you'd like to try an exciting adventure.

Early in the morning, take advantage of the open buffet breakfast on board the MS Nile Radamis Egypt Nile River Cruise. Then, you will enjoy your Luxor day tours as your private driver and Egyptologist tour guide pick you up to begin your West Bank of Luxor tour to the Valley of the Kings.

You can visit the Temple of Hatshepsut, which is also known as the <u>Temple of El Dier El Bahari</u>, and the enormous colossal statues of King Amenhotep III, which is known as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. Once you arrive at the Valley of the Kings, your tour guide will explain to you how the royal tomb evolved in ancient Egypt.

When you finish the tour, your Egyptologist guide will take you back to the Nile Cruise and your tasty lunch will be served on board, then the boat will sail to Edfu.

After enjoying your dinner, you will spend the night in Edfu.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3: Visit Edfu & Kom Ombo temples

Eat your fill of a delicious and fresh breakfast before starting your journey and visit some of our well-known sites, like the <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, which is a massive structure with two towers and two granite statues of Horus in the form of a falcon. This temple was built where the God Horus was worshipped. Then, we'll keep sailing to Aswan.

A delectable lunch will be served on board the cruise ship prior to your arrival in Aswan, and we'll make a stop at Kom Ombo, which is a small settlement with a long history. Your certified Egyptologist guide will pick you up and take you to the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo, which was constructed to honor the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris, before sailing down the Nile to Aswan.

After dinner is served on board in the evening, you can watch the Nubian performance.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4 : Sightseeing Tour in Aswan

Your filling open-buffet breakfast will be served on the boat before you are transferred to enjoy <u>Aswan day tours</u>, which start with a visit to the impressive <u>High Dam</u> in Aswan. This dam was constructed to regulate the Nile's water during the agricultural year, making it simple to conserve water and produce electricity. Now you will see one of the most interesting temples constructed in the same style of architecture as in the Greco-Roman era, <u>Philae Temple</u> which was dedicated to the worship of <u>Goddess Isis</u>. Continue on to The Unfinished Obelisk in the Granite Quarries, which was probably made for <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> but was never finished.

In the evening, you will enjoy your savory lunch while sailing with your MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise. Your dinner will also be served aboard your Nile Cruise and overnight in the amazing city and things to do in Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation from The Nile cruise
