Day 1 : Arrive to Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

Your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to assist with the immigration process and you will be transferred in a private vehicle to the start of your fantastic Egypt trip. Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour

After breakfast, you will be met by your English-speaking tour guide to begin your tour of the Giza <u>Pyramids</u>. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son <u>Chephren</u> are two of the world's oldest wonders that are still standing today. You will also see <u>the Valley Temple</u> of King Chephren, <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, and the King Mycerinus Pyramid, which are all on the Giza Plateau, just outside of Cairo.

You will be taken to the Egyptian Museum, which has two stories and houses the largest collection of Egyptian artifacts in existence, as well as the one-of-a-kind golden treasure that was unearthed undamaged in

the Valley of the Kings and was formerly owned by the young king Tutankhamun. He is one of the Egyptian family's eighteen parishioners, dating back to ancient Egypt. Tutankhamun, like many other pharaohs, is among the most well-known for reasons unrelated to his accomplishments or the victories he had in combat.

After that, we'll begin our <u>tour of Coptic Cairo</u> by going to the ancient Roman fortification of Babylon and <u>the Hanging Church</u>, which is perched above the fort's two towers. You will visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is a historic Jewish synagogue situated in Old Cairo and Abu Serga Church.

Enjoy your meal at a reputable Egyptian eatery. After seeing the most well-known mosques constructed during the Islamic era and <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, Cairo's historic bazaar. After finishing your Islamic Cairo tour, we will transfer you again to your hotel.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Day 4 : West Bank of Luxor

While floating near <u>Edfu</u>, which is situated on the west bank of the Nile River in southern Egypt, take pleasure in your delicious meal.

Enjoy your fresh food-filled open buffet meal in the evening, then get ready for some entertainment, including musical performances and belly dancing.

An optional <u>hot air balloon</u> ride over Luxor's beautiful historic ruins and the breathtaking Nile River landscape is a well-liked and breathtaking experience.

On the west bank of the Nile River near the city of Edfu, the Temple of Horus is one of the most comprehensive ancient Egyptian temples. The building of the temple took roughly 180 years. Then As the Nile cruise ship heads toward Aswan, enjoy your lunch, which is being provided to you.
