Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and visiting Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

One of our representatives from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at Cairo International Airport to assist you with passport control. You can start your Cairo day tours from the airport or by leaving your luggage at the hotel before departing for a tour of the magnificent Sphinx and the Giza Pyramids. Your tour guide will give you a thorough explanation of the pyramids, including how scientists believe they were built in antiquity. He or she will also be available to answer any questions you may have about famous ancient Egyptian pharaohs like Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus.

You will also be transferred to visit the Pyramids of Saqqara. The most historic stone building from ancient Egypt is the Step Pyramid of King Djoser, where you can start your sightseeing. You will visit the Dahshur Pyramids after enjoying your delectable lunch during the tour. The tour includes visiting the Bent Pyramid, a well-preserved archeological site, and inside King Senefru's Red Pyramid, which was built by his father, King Senefru. The Dahshur region is known for its royal necropolis and numerous Pyramids, including the Great Pyramid, which was built by King Cheops. The tour also includes a visit to King Senefru's Red Pyramid.

Memphis is the last site we'll see today. One of two enormous statues of Ramses II will be on display during your visit, and the other will be on display at the new, impressive Egyptian museum next to the magnificent Alabaster Sphinx. This city was established by King Menes in 3100 B.C. after Upper and Lower Egypt were united.

Your personal driver and tour guide will accompany you to your hotel and assist you with the check-in process in the late afternoon after finishing your tour. Spend your first night in Cairo.

Day 02 : Alexandria Day Tour

Your licensed guide and private driver will meet you after breakfast at the hotel to start your Alexandria Sightseeing Tour. You will begin your tour in Cairo and travel to Alexandria, which was founded in 332 B.C. by the illustrious ruler <u>Alexander the Great</u>, who is one of the Greek kings of Macedonia and one of the most illustrious military leaders and conquerors in history.

The Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, which are in Alexandria, Egypt, and date back to the second century AD, will be the first stop on our <u>day tour of Alexandria</u> after you arrive. <u>The catacombs'</u> distinctive fusion of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman architectural designs illustrates the period's varied cultural influences. we'll take a short drive to see <u>Pompey's pillar</u>, the tallest standing pillar in Egypt.

When you reach the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was built in 1477 AD on the site where the renowned Pharos lighthouse once stood, you will then be taken to the seaside to take in the views of the Mediterranean Sea. Enjoy a seafood lunch at a high-end restaurant before visiting the Modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria, a three-building building. Explore the city's major squares, neighborhood markets, and famous sites like the

"Unknown Soldiers" monument and modern politician statues. Your tour guide and chauffeur will return you to Cairo, with a coffee or tea break along the way.

Spend another night at the hotel in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo Tour

Immerse yourself in Cairo's rich history with our guided tours. Begin your day with breakfast at your hotel before visiting the Egyptian Museum to explore the extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities, including King Tutankhamen's golden mask and coffins. Afterward, delve into Islamic Cairo, where you'll visit the Citadel of Saladin and the magnificent Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque. Due to the marble paneling on its interior and exterior walls, this mosque is also referred to as the "Alabaster Mosque". The twin minarets of the mosque are the tallest in all of Egypt, standing 84 meters tall each.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before continuing to Coptic Cairo, where you'll discover the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church, and the church of St Sergius. Our Coptic Cairo tour will conclude with a visit to the old Jewish area of Cairo to see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was once a Christian church before being sold to a Jewish man. Conclude the day by exploring the vibrant streets of Islamic Cairo, including El Moez Ledin Ellah Street, the Al Azhar Mosque, and a visit to the historic El Fishawy café in Khan El Khalili. These tours offer a fascinating glimpse into Cairo's rich heritage and cultural treasures.

We will take the car back to the hotel and stay the night in Cairo.

Day 4 : Cairo to Luxor

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, check out and proceed to Cairo airport for your domestic flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, our team will be there to greet you and transfer you to your hotel for some rest, if possible. If not, we will begin our tour of Luxor's west bank immediately.

We'll start with the famous <u>Valley of the Kings</u> was the burial site of the Eighteenth, Nineteenth, and Twentieth Dynasties of Egypt's New Kingdom, located across the river from Thebes (modern Luxor). Next, we'll visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also called the <u>temple of Deir El Bahari</u>, and the Colossi of Memnon, the remaining structures from King Amenophis III's mortuary temple, which face the Nile.

After lunch in Luxor, we'll tour the East Bank, visiting the Karnak Temple Complex and the Avenue of the Sphinxes. We'll see the Unfinished Pylon of King Nectanebo and the hypostyle hall with 134 columns. Our guide will lead us to the largest standing obelisk in Egypt, built by Queen Hatshepsut. We'll also visit the temple of Amon, adorned with lotus and papyrus designs, and admire the Granite Scarab of Amenophis III.

To conclude our day, we'll take a short car ride to the magnificent <u>Luxor Temple</u>, a masterpiece of ancient Egyptian architecture. This site holds great historical significance and is a sight to behold.

These tours in Luxor will allow you to immerse yourself in the wonders of ancient Egypt while exploring the fascinating history and architectural marvels of the region. You have the opportunity to enjoy additional

excursions in Luxor, including a visit to see the Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple.

Spend your night in Luxor.

Day 5: Luxor to Aswan

You will receive the checkout instructions from your hotel at 7:00 in the morning. After that, it will take about 3 hours for you to travel by land from Luxor to Aswan. As soon as you get there, you'll start your Aswan sightseeing by going to the Aswan High Dam, an approximately \$1 billion rock-fill dam constructed across the Nile River in Aswan, Egypt, that was completed in 1970. After that, your tour guide will direct you to a boat that will take you to the Philae Temple, which survived the 1960s drowning in the Nile.

Once the <u>Aswan day tours</u> are completed, you will be treated to a delicious lunch in Aswan, followed by transportation to your hotel in Aswan to check-in.

Day 6 : Abu Simbel to Cairo

You will arrive back in Aswan around 1:00 pm, at which point a transfer will take you to the airport so you can board your flight back to Cairo.
