Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrive Cairo/ Check-in

The Cairo Top Tours airport representative will meet you at the Cairo International Airport when you arrive and assist you with all the airport procedures. You will then be driven to your hotel for check-in and overnight in a private air-conditioned vehicle.

Welcome, Drink.

Day 02: Giza Pyramids and the Egyptian Museum Tour

Breakfast at the hotel before a <u>Cairo</u> day tour, including a visit to <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, designed by French architect Marcel Dourgnon, and opened by Khedive Abbas Helmy II in 1902. The tour then takes you to <u>the Giza Pyramids</u>, where King Khufu built the Great Pyramid and Khafre and Menkaure received smaller pyramids.

You will also visit The Great Sphinx of Giza is the most famous. It was carved directly out of the bedrock during the 4th Dynasty, which also makes it the oldest. Ancient Egyptian sphinxes represented the king with the body of a lion, in a clear demonstration of his power.

Have your local lunch before starting the <u>Islamic Cairo trips</u> by visiting <u>Khan El Khalili</u> Bazaar. which is the oldest remaining market in Cairo, take your time walking around the area to see the impressive mosques of Islamic Cairo and the old buildings along with a possibility to buy exquisite gifts and enjoy a pleasant Cairo shopping tour to remind you of your great tours in Egypt.

Then transfer back to your hotel.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo to Aswan/ Aswan Excursions/ Kom Ombo Temple

After checking out, you will be transferred to Cairo International Airport for your flight to Aswan to hold on your 7 days in Cairo and your Nile cruise vacation, after which you will meet our representative, who will transfer you to a cruise on the Nile. Begin your Egyptian Nile cruise before lunch is served on board. Start your day trip in Aswan to visit the Aswan High Dam and the Philae Temple repurposed as a church by early Christians, and take a boat trip to Kom Ombo. On the next day, you will visit the renowned Kom Ombo Temple, which was utilized for the veneration of two deities of Ancient Egypt: the Crocodile God of Fertility, Sobek, and the Ancient Form of Horus the Falcon, Haroeris. Afterward, you will embark on a sailing journey to the ancient city of Edfu. Enjoy a delicious dinner served on board your Nile cruise boat and savor an enjoyable evening.

Overnight in Edfu.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 4 : Edfu Temple/ Sail to Luxor

After a leisurely breakfast on board the cruise ship, you will be transferred to a destination. One of the most impressive and comprehensive <u>ancient Egyptian</u> temples, the Temple of <u>Horus</u> in Edfu is used to worship the god Horus. putatively located on the western bank of the Nile. You will cross the lock and sail to <u>Luxor</u> once your visit to <u>the Edfu Temple</u> is complete. Enjoy your afternoon tea, followed by dinner on board your Nile River Cruise, and then spend the evening at the Galabeya party.

Overnight in Luxor.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5 : Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy a delicious breakfast on board the Nile Cruise vessel to start your day. Then our representative will take you to cross the Nile River to the west bank to visit the Valley of the Kings. The East and West Valleys separate the Valley of the Kings. Given that the western valley only has a few tombs, the eastern valley is by far the more famous of the two. Twenty unfinished tombs that are little more than pits are added to the Valley of the Kings' total of over sixty tombs.

Then visit the Temple of Deir El Bahari. After that, you will stop at the Colossi of Memnon which are two gigantic sitting statues depicting Amenhotep III facing the Nile. After the west bank of Luxor tour is over, you will enjoy your lunch aboard the ship.

Optional (Hot air Balloon Ride)

Afternoon tea and overnight in Luxor.

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Tour/ Back to Cairo

Luxor day tours to the East Bank of the Nile River start after leaving the Nile Cruise. Visit the Karnak Temple, a massive collection of sixty-one acres of <u>temples</u>, home to Amun Ra, the male god of Thebes. The central area features his wife, Mut, and <u>the Temple of Luxor</u>, showcasing a courtyard, enormous columns, and granite statues of Ramses II.

The Karnak Temple Complex, which was constructed over the course of ancient Egyptian history. The unfinished pylon, the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive columns, the tallest standing obelisks of Queen Hatshepsut and Tuthmosis III, the temple of the god Amun decorated with lotus (water lily) and papyrus forms, the Granite Scarab beetle of Amenophis III, which was worshipped and called kb, and the Sacred Lake are all in front of the Avenue of Sphinxes.

You will be transferred to Luxor airport to catch your flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival at Cairo airport, a Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you to be transferred to your hotel.

Overnight in Cairo hotel.

Day 7: Final Departure
