Afterward, take a visit to the Temple of Luxor, an exquisite ancient structure, offers a glimpse into the history of different Egyptian reigns. The temple is not the product of a single ruler's ambition; instead, it evolved over time.

Return to your Luxor Nile cruise at the night to see the great view of the Nile.

Day 5: The West Bank of Luxor

Today we will move to the west bank of Luxor to watch <u>The Valley of the Kings</u> is an ancient burial ground on the West Bank of Luxor. It served as the final resting place for numerous pharaohs of the New Kingdom period.

Continue to <u>The Hatshepsut Temple</u>, also known as the Temple of Deir el-Bahri, is an impressive mortuary temple built during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. The temple was designed and supervised by Senenmut, a high-ranking official in her court.

Next, The <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> are two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. These imposing statues once guarded the entrance to the pharaoh's mortuary temple, which no longer stands today.

And after this long tour, you will go back to the cruise to have a rest.

Day 6: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After breakfast on board the cruise, you will begin the day by visiting the <u>Edfu Temple</u>, an Egyptian temple located on the west bank of the Nile in Edfu. The city was known as "Apollonopolis Magna" in the Hellenistic and Latin periods, after the chief deity Horus.

Next, you will visit Kom Ombo Temple, a fascinating ancient Egyptian site, stands majestically on the banks of the Nile River in Aswan Governorate, Egypt. This remarkable temple, dedicated to the worship of two deities, Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus, the falcon-headed god.

Day 7: Aswan Day Tours

After having breakfast on the cruise, get ready to start the day visiting two wonderful sites.

Begin your day by taking you to The High Dam, also known as the Aswan High Dam, which is an iconic engineering project. Construction of the dam began in 1960 and was completed in 1970. It spans the Nile

River and is situated around 6 kilometers south of the city of Aswan.

Next, you'll explore the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, believed to have been initiated during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. This colossal structure was intended for placement in the Karnak Temple.

After all the time you will spend, we will transfer you to the airport to get a flight to Cairo, and after reaching Cairo Airport we will take you to the hotel for breakfast only.

Day 9: A Day Tour in Fayum
