<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Embarkation to MS Nile Radamis - East Bank sightseeing

On your first day in Egypt, a tour manager from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at Luxor Airport, the railway station, or your hotel and take you to the MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise in an air-conditioned vehicle. After having a tasty buffet lunch on the cruise, you will embark on a tour of the East Bank of Luxor with your guide. Your first stop will be the grand Karnak Temple, which was devoted to the sun god Amun-Ra, goddess Mut, and their son, the moon god Khonso. Next, you will visit the marvelous Luxor Temple, which is one of the most well-known temples constructed during the New Kingdom era. In the evening, you will enjoy a delicious dinner on the cruise ship while watching an entertaining folkloric show. You will spend the night in Luxor City.

Meals included: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2: West Bank Tours (Valley of the kings and queen Hatshepsut temple)

For an exciting adventure, you can opt to join a Hot Air Balloon Ride in Luxor in the early morning. After enjoying an open buffet breakfast on board the MS Nile Radamis Egypt Nile River Cruise, continue your Luxor day tours with your Egyptologist guide and private driver who will take you to the West Bank of Luxor. Explore the Valley of the Kings and learn about the royal tombs in ancient Egypt. Visit the Temple of Hatshepsut, also known as the Temple of El Dier El Bahari, and see the colossal statues of King Amenhotep III, known as the Colossi of Memnon. After the tour, return to the Nile Cruise for a tasty lunch onboard and then sail to Edfu. Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Edfu.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3: Visit Edfu & Kom Ombo temples

Your Egypt luxury package continues this morning with a delicious breakfast served on board the Nile River cruise ship made from fresh ingredients. After breakfast, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will accompany you to visit the Edfu Temple of God Horus, the protector of kingship, depicted as a falcon-headed man with two great wings. The boat will then sail towards Aswan, stopping at the town of Kom Ombo, known from ancient times, where you will explore the Ptolemaic Temple of Kom Ombo with your accredited Egyptologist guide, built to honor the crocodile Gods of ancient Egypt, Sobek, and Haroeris.

After lunch on board, the boat will continue sailing down the Nile to Aswan. Enjoy dinner on board in the evening while watching the Nubian show.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: Sightseeing Tour in Aswan

Start your day with a delicious open-buffet breakfast on board the boat before heading out for <u>Aswan Day tours</u>. Your first stop will be the Great <u>High Dam</u>, built to control the Nile water during the agricultural year, saving water, and generating electric power. Next, visit <u>the Unfinished Obelisk</u> in the granite quarries, which was probably made for Queen Hatshepsut but was never finished. Then, explore the <u>Philae Temple</u>, one of the most interesting temples built in the same style of architecture as in the Greco-Roman era, dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis.

Enjoy a savory lunch while sailing with your MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise in the evening. Your dinner will also be served aboard the boat, and you will spend the night in the amazing city of Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation from The Nile cruise

In the morning, you have the option to join a tour of the majestic Abu Simbel temples built by King Ramses II for himself and his wife Queen Nefertari. After breakfast, it's time to disembark from your MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise and conclude your Egypt travel package. Your tour manager will transfer you to Aswan Airport or the railway station.
