The Bibliotheca of Alexandria:

Luxor Temple:

Located approximately three kilometers south of the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, the Luxor Temple was once connected to the latter by a magnificent walking road, adorned with statues of the Great Sphinx and the ram-headed Sphinx.

Valley of the Kings:

Explore the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where the ancient kings' tombs were hidden underground to protect their treasures from robbers.

Tutankhamun:

Discover the history of the young pharaoh <u>Tutankhamun</u>, who ascended to the throne at the age of nine. His name in ancient Egyptian translates to "the living image of the god Amun," an important deity in Egyptian mythology.

Day 6: (West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu)

• Colossi of Memnon:

Marvel at the impressive statues of King Amenhotep III, known as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which once guarded the ancient funerary temple of the king.

Hatshepsut Temple:

Visit the uniquely designed <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, with its three successive floors on open terraces, setting it apart from other Egyptian temples.

Karnak Temple:

Explore the grandeur of the <u>Karnak Temple</u> complex, consisting of a diverse group of numerous temples built from the 11th Dynasty around 2134 BC. The temples are enclosed by brick walls and interconnected by corridors adorned with rows of sphinxes, famously known as the Avenue of Rams.

- Enjoy a delightful lunch while cruising towards Edfu. In the evening, indulge in an open buffet dinner featuring fresh ingredients, followed by entertainment with musical shows and belly dancing.

Day 7: (The temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo)

Start your day with a delicious breakfast before commencing your day's visits to the following temples:

Temple of Edfu:

Explore the well-preserved <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, dedicated to the worship of the god Horus, a significant figure in Egyptian mythology. This temple stands as one of the best-preserved ancient structures.

Temple of Kom Ombo:

Visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, which got its name from the legendary king "Emboa." The name consists of two syllables, "Kom" meaning what is above the earth, and "Ombo" referring to the king or ruler of the valley.

For dinner, you will be treated to the finest Egyptian ingredients while onboard the Nile cruise. As you dine, you will be entertained by the captivating Nubian Show.

Day 9: (Disembarkation - Going back to Cairo)

Begin your day early with a visit to the breathtaking <u>Abu Simbel</u>, located in Nubia near the southern border of Egypt. This magnificent monument, known as the Great Temple of Abu Simbel, was built by

King Ramses II of the Nineteenth Dynasty around 1264 BC. It stands as one of the most splendid monuments in Egypt, carved entirely into the mountain.

After enjoying a delicious breakfast, it's time to check out from the cruise ship. Our representative will then transfer you to Aswan Airport for your return flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, you will catch your connecting flight to Amman.

Day meal: Breakfast.

Day 10: (Nebo Mount / Dead Sea)

After breakfast, you will be transported by an air-conditioned car to visit the following destinations:

Mount Nebo:

Explore <u>Mount Nebo</u>, whose name originates from the Babylonian god of trade, "Naba." The area was once home to the city of Nebo, which witnessed significant historical events, including battles inscribed on the obelisk of King Mesha, the King of Moab. The city was eventually abandoned, and in the 4th century AD, a Christian Bedouin tribe built a church there.

The Dead Sea:

Visit the <u>Dead Sea</u>, a closed salt lake located within the Jordan Valley in the Syrian-African fissure, straddling the border between Jordan and historical Palestine (the West Bank and Palestine). The Dead Sea is renowned for being the lowest point on Earth's surface, with its beach level approximately 400 meters below sea level.

After the day's exploration, you will be taken back for an overnight stay.

Day meal: Breakfast.

Day 11: (Petra tour)

After breakfast in the morning, you will be taken on a journey to Petra. Check-in at the Tetra Tree Hotel upon arrival.

Visit <u>Petra</u>, a historical and archaeological marvel credited to the Nabateans, who built this aweinspiring city. Before the Nabataeans, the Edomites inhabited the area, engaging in hostilities with neighboring nations. Human presence in the hills around Petra dates back to 1200-539 BC.

Enjoy your overnight stay at Petra, surrounded by the beauty and history of this ancient city.

Day meal: Breakfast.

Day 12: (Free day)

Today, you have a free day to explore Petra at your own pace and leisure. Your tour leader will present optional tours for you to consider if you are interested.
