The first destination is the awe-inspiring [Karnak Temple](#), an impressive complex featuring temples, pavilions, pylons, and obelisks, all dedicated to the Theban gods and the illustrious Egyptian kings. Karnak holds significant importance as the primary place of worship in the Theban triangle, devoted to Amun, Mut, and Khonsu.

Next, we'll visit [Luxor Temple](#), predominantly constructed by New Kingdom pharaoh Amenhotep III, and later completed by King Tutankhamun and the renowned King Ramses II. Ramses II also raised the first pylon, which proudly displays his military victory at the Battle of Kadesh. You'll notice the mosque of Abu Al-Haggag, standing on the remains of an ancient church, adding an intriguing layer of history to this sacred site.

Afterward, we'll head back to the Nile Cruise for a delectable lunch, followed by a captivating folkloric show. Enjoy a delightful dinner on board and spend a comfortable night as the cruise sets sail towards your next fascinating destinations.

Day 2: West Bank of Luxor and sail to Edfu

Begin an unforgettable journey through ancient Egypt with our Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride and West Bank Archaeological Tour. Witness the breathtaking sunrise over Luxor's iconic landscapes during a 30-45 minute hot air balloon ride. The open-air museum city of Luxor, with its great temples and majestic mountains, will unfold before your eyes from the sky.

Witness the beauty of [Elephantine Island](#), the largest island near Aswan, where various monuments, including the ruins of a temple dedicated to the ram god Khnum, have been discovered.

As the day draws to a close, relax and unwind on the cruise ship, spending the night on the serene waters of the Nile.

Day 5: Aswan day tour / Disembarkation

On the final day of our journey, disembark from the cruise after breakfast and embark on an enriching exploration of Aswan's iconic landmarks. Begin with a visit to the remarkable Aswan [High Dam](#), a monumental achievement and one of Egypt's most significant accomplishments of the last century. Next, immerse yourself in the mystical ambiance of the Temple of Isis in Philae.
