Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor East Bank Tours

Upon your arrival at <u>Luxor airport</u> or station, our representative will greet you and provide a private van transfer to your Nile cruise ship. Once you embark, you'll have some time to settle in and relax. In the afternoon, your exploration of <u>Luxor's East Bank</u> will begin.

Your first stop will be the <u>Karnak Temple</u> Complex, an awe-inspiring site that holds the distinction of being the largest structure ever built in human history.

Afterward, you'll proceed to visit the <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, Situated at the heart of ancient Thebes, the temple, like Karnak, was dedicated to the chief god Amun Re. Explore the intricate details and historical significance of this remarkable structure.

Once the day tour concludes, you'll be transferred back to your ship, where you can rest and refresh. In the evening, the ship's staff will entertain you with an Egyptian folkloric show, providing a delightful cultural experience. Enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Luxor.

Note: If you arrive in Luxor early in the day, we will commence the tour immediately upon your arrival to make the most of your time, as we understand the importance of not having our guests wait in the lobby for check-in.

Meals included: lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank - Sail to Edfu

On the Nile cruise, breakfast. Then you'll begin your enchanted tour of Thebes, the sacred region, by seeing the west bank of Luxor and <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, which is thought to be the royal cemetery of the Theban kings and rulers of ancient Egypt and the location where our Pharaohs were interred. You will next go to Deir El Bahari to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Because it was entirely carved into the mountain, this temple is regarded as one of the most beautiful specimens of ancient Egyptian architecture. You will see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which belonged to King Amenhotep III, at the conclusion of the journey. You will then head back to your ship to eat lunch. Afternoon, free at leisure. Dinner and overnight on the cruise.

Day 3: Edfu - Kom Ombo - Sail to Aswan

Onboard your Nile cruise, and breakfast. The voyage to the country of mysteries will then be mysterious, led by your tour guide. The Temple of Horus at Edfu, which is regarded as one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, is the first stop on this guided tour today. It is one of the most beautiful temples in all of Egypt. You will then return to your ship after that. While traveling to Kom Ombo, lunch will be served on board.

You will move on to explore the Temple of Kom Ombo in the afternoon, which is where the two gods Sobek and Haroeris were once worshipped. Return to your ship and have a lunch break. Enjoy the sun terrace while observing the Nile's distinctive landscape. the banks of the ancient Egyptian civilization have been created and flourished.

A dinner meal will be served onboard during the sailing to the city of Aswan. Late evening arrives in Aswan, and overnight

Day 4: Aswan City Tour

There will be breakfast provided on your ship. On the way to Agilika Island, where you will visit the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, a building constructed during the Greco-Roman era and dedicated to the goddess Isis (mother of the god Horus), you will later join your Egyptologist tour guide to explore the great city of Aswan, including <u>The High Dam</u>, The <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, a magnificent site in Aswan formed of red granite and dedicated to the god Amun Ra, will be the last place you are taken. You will return to your ship after your day trip is over. On board, lunch will be provided. On board, afternoon tea will be provided. free to enjoy oneself at night. Aswan's dinner and overnight stay.
