Itinerary

Day 1: Monday: Aswan Tours - Sail to Edfu

Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you at the <u>Aswan airport</u> or at the train station to transfer you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to embark on your mövenpick Sunray Nile Cruise Aswan to Luxor which sets sail every Monday from Aswan to Luxor. In the afternoon, you will start the <u>Aswan day tours</u> enjoying the whole nation, Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, the Granite quarries where you will see the largest obelisk in the history of Egypt which is made by Queen Hatshepsut but sadly was not finished, the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, and the Greco-Roman temple that was built for the worship of one of the most remarkable deities in ancient Egyptian Religion, the famous goddess Isis, explore the magnificent <u>Philae Temple</u>, Then we will sail to <u>Kom Ombo</u> while enjoying dinner aboard your Sunray Nile Cruise ship from Aswan to Luxor.

Day 2: Tuesday: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples - Sail to Luxor

You will go to Kom Ombo in the early morning, where you will explore the enormous Temple of Kom Ombo that is devoted to the two deities, which your knowledgeable guide will describe in detail at the location. While traveling to Edfu to see one of the best-preserved temples in Egyptian history, you can also take in the colorful local markets where you can purchase gifts and have lunch. Take the horse-drawn carriage to the famed Temple of Edfu, one of Egypt's most stunning temples that dates back to the Ptolemaic era. The Temple of Edfu is one of Egypt's largest temples and is devoted to the god Horus.

Day 3: Wednesday: Luxor Sightseeing Tours

It will be time to begin <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u> after breakfast by seeing the enormous necropolis known as the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where a number of ancient Egyptian pharaohs and nobles were interred in crypts carved out of the cliffs. You will also see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, which are two enormous statues of King Amenhotep III. The temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, the second female pharaoh in ancient Egypt and one of its most powerful monarchs, will be your next stop. After lunch, go back to the boat. We start our trip to the East Bank of Luxor in the late afternoon.

During tours of Luxor, stroll between the pillars of the Amun Ra temple and along the Avenue of the Sphinxes in the Karnak temple, which was constructed over two millennia to be a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art, a blueprint of the might and glory of a golden age, and a treasure trove of historical knowledge. Continue to take in the splendor of the Luxor temple, which serves as another illustration of the grandeur of the pharaohs and monarchs of the ancient Egyptian New Kingdom. Following supper, you can watch a belly dancing performance. and stay in Luxor for the night.

Day 4: Thursday: End of our Service
