# **Day 1: Embarkation - Aswan Nile Cruise Tours**

Our agent will greet you at the train or airport in Aswan, take you to your accommodation in a luxurious air-conditioned vehicle, and begin your four-day Royal Viking Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Your Aswan excursions begin after lunch at the Aswan High Dam, built in 1960 to shield Egypt from the Nile River's yearly floods.

During your tour of the Giza Pyramids, don't miss seeing the Unfinished Obelisk, which is renowned for its red granite, which was utilized to build numerous well-known structures, including the Valley Temple of King Chephren and the pyramid of Mycerinus. The most well-known obelisk is related to Queen Hatshepsut, the first female ruler of Egypt in history. She was the wife of King Tuthmosis II and one of the queens who ruled during the 18th dynasty during the new kingdom. There is currently no proof to support the theory put up by some that this obelisk is connected to Queen Nefertiti, the wife of King Akhenaten.

Proceed with your <u>Aswan</u> excursions to see the Temple of Philae, which honors the goddess of magic, Goddess Isis. Moved from Philae Island to Agilika Island as a result of the construction of the High Dam, the Temple of Philae is devoted to her. Once you've transferred back to the cruise ship, eat supper while sipping on the captain's welcome drink.

### Day 2: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast on board the cruise ship, followed by an excursion to the Sobek temple in Kom Ombo, dedicated to two ancient Egyptian gods: Horus and Sobek. Lunch on board, then sail to Edfu, the best-preserved temple of Horus, son of Osiris and protector of kingship. Dinner aboard the boat before sailing towards Luxor.

## **Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours**

Breakfast in the morning on the stunning Royal Viking Nile Cruise. After lunch, visit the Luxor Temple, which dates back to the New Kingdom. Amenhotep III, who constructed the interior of the temple, and Ramses II, who finished it, were two of the greatest pharaohs in ancient Egyptian history. It was connected to the Karnak Temple by an avenue of sphinxes. Continue your Luxor east bank tours to see the Temple of Karnak, which was the most important religious site in ancient Egypt, particularly during the New Kingdom. Like previous Egyptian temples, the primary temple was devoted to the

worship of the deity Amun, but other deities were also there and were worshipped. Dinner and stay on the cruise ship

# **Day 4: Disembarkation - Luxor West Bank Tours**

Optionally, you can take a hot air balloon flight in Luxor.

The Luxor west bank tours begin with a visit to the Valley of the Kings, where pharaohs were buried during the New Kingdom. The Temple of Hatshepsut, built by Queen Hatshepsut's lover, Senmout, is a unique and monumental structure. The Colossi of Memnon, two massive statues of King Amenhotep III, are also a highlight. The tour concludes with a transfer to the airport or train station.
