Day 1- Cairo Airport - Siwa Oasis

You will meet our tour guide at the [Cairo International Airport](#) when you arrive. They will take you to the Siwa oasis in a cozy, air-conditioned car; we might stop for coffee along the way. We'll assist you with a quick check-in at your hotel upon arrival so you can unwind before starting your tour the following day.

Day 2: Discover the Siwa Oasis

We will arrange to pick you up at 7 a.m. from your hotel to begin your exciting day exploring Siwa Oasis. Our first stop will be the [Alexander the Great Temple](#), also known as the Temple of the Oracle. According to legend, Alexander the Great sought confirmation of his divine parentage from the oracle at this temple. It is said that the gods and their entourage traversed a vast expanse of desert to reach Siwa Oasis.

Next, we will visit the nearby salt lake, where you can enjoy a unique swimming experience in its buoyant saltwater. Afterward, we will take you to [Cleopatra's bathroom](#), also known as the spring of the sun. It is believed that Cleopatra herself used to swim in this natural spring.

Continuing our tour, we will head to the Umm Ubaydah temple, also known as [the Amun temple](#). This temple was constructed by Nectanebo, a pharaoh from the 30th Dynasty of Egypt.

To satisfy your taste buds, we will treat you to a delicious meal at [Mountain Of The Dead](#) while you savor the flavors of Siwan cuisine.

As the day progresses, we will venture into the Great Sand Sea, where you can enjoy the thrill of driving a 4x4 Jeep and take a refreshing dip in hot and cold springs. As dusk approaches, we will pause to experience the traditional Bedouin hospitality and enjoy a cup of tea before setting up our tent for the night. Alternatively, if you prefer, we can arrange accommodation in one of the excellent eco-lodges available in Siwa Oasis.

Relish the tranquil ambiance, indulge in a barbecue dinner, and immerse yourself in the beauty of the desert under the starry night sky.

Day 3: Siwa Oasis Tours

You will be served breakfast at the camp at 7:00 a.m., then you will be transported back to Siwa Oasis. The next stop on the itinerary is the conical Mountain of the Dead, situated a little over a kilometer north of Shali. Before that, you will have the opportunity to explore the Shali Fort and enjoy some free time for shopping in the area.

Our next destination is Fatnas Lake, which can be reached on foot or by bicycle from Birket Siwa. The small island of Fatnas in the lake provides a picturesque setting, with the majestic Gebel Bayda and Hamra mountains serving as a stunning backdrop to the west. This area is perfect for unwinding and witnessing the breathtaking sunset over the lake. As you explore the garden, you'll come across a variety of trees, including banana, date, and olive trees, adding to the natural beauty of the surroundings.

Afterward, you will be transferred to your accommodation in Siwa Oasis, where you can relax and enjoy the comforts of your chosen lodging.

Day 4: Siwa to Cairo

You can choose to stay in Siwa longer before going to Cairo. It is worthwhile to try Siwa's famed dates, olives, and syrups. The list also contains well-known lamps, relaxing and restorative herbs, beverages, and items made entirely of salt from the Siwa salt lakes. then drive you to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 5: Tour to the Giza Pyramids and Egyptian Museum

One of our professional tour guides will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo and transfer you in a private, contemporary vehicle to the [Giza pyramids](#) to start your full-day excursion. Visit the Great Pyramid of King Cheops at the Giza Pyramids, also referred to as the "Famous Pyramids of Egypt," and then take a 20-minute camel ride to discover more about [Egyptian history](#).
