Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

With your name on a signboard, our tour guide will be waiting for you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. You will ride in a contemporary, air-conditioned car as it takes you to the hotel in Cairo. In addition to helping you with check-in processes, our tour guide will go over the itinerary and Egypt's top attractions with you to confirm the time of pick-up for the tour of the <u>Giza pyramids</u> and the Egyptian Museum the next day.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Egyptian Museum Trip

You will meet our knowledgeable tour guide in the morning to be transferred to begin your seven-day Egypt holiday and see the Giza Pyramids, which are regarded as one of the most amazing structures ever created by a man. the Valley Temple of Chephren, where the mummification process was carried out, as well as the little pyramid of Mankurea. The Egyptian Museum, the oldest archaeological museum in the Middle East, is where you'll see the best examples of Egyptian antiquities as well as the <u>Tutankhamen</u> collection. <u>The Egyptian Museum</u> is home to more than 170,000 objects.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tour
