Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Coptic Cairo Tours

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel, get ready for an exciting <u>Cairo day tour</u>. Your knowledgeable English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel lobby and accompany you to the Giza Necropolis, where you'll embark on an amazing tour of the Giza Pyramids.

Marvel at the grandeur of these colossal structures, built by the renowned kings and rulers of ancient Egypt during the 4th dynasty of the Old Kingdom, approximately 4500 years ago. The Great Pyramid of Cheops, standing at a height of 146 meters and comprised of 2.3 million limestone blocks, serves as a testament to the greatness and advancement of our ancestors.

From a panoramic viewpoint, you'll have a stunning view of the plateau, allowing you to see the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus. If you'd like, you can also opt for a camel ride in the Giza Pyramids area. Your tour guide will point out interesting vantage points for capturing the best photos, ensuring lasting memories of your Egypt tours.

We'll then proceed to Cairo's downtown, specifically El Tahrir Square, to begin your Egyptian Museum tour. Spend approximately two hours exploring the museum's two floors, where you'll discover a wealth of artifacts from the Pharaonic era. The Egyptian Museum, established through the efforts of Auguste Mariette and opened in 1902, houses a remarkable collection, including the golden treasures of the young King Tutankhamun and the funerary collection of Yuya and Tuya, the grandparents of King Akhenaten.

Enjoy a delightful lunch at a high-quality restaurant before continuing your Cairo sightseeing tour to the area known as Old Cairo. Here, you'll embark on an informative <u>Coptic Cairo</u> tour. Start with a visit

to <u>the Hanging Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, one of the oldest churches dating back to the 7th century. Inside, you'll find ancient icons that commemorate the early days of Christianity in Egypt. Continue to explore the Cave Church of Abu Serga, built to honor two Christian martyrs who endured torture for their faith, and the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was once a Christian church and is now one of the few Jewish synagogues in Egypt.

Conclude your day with a visit to the vibrant Khan El Khalili market, a remarkable area in Islamic Cairo. Immerse yourself in the bustling atmosphere, where narrow alleys paved 800 years ago are filled with colorful products. Experience the warmth of the local people and take your time exploring the monuments along Al Moez Street. Don't forget to savor a traditional mint tea at El Fishawy, a popular local café.

Return to your hotel for overnight accommodation and a well-deserved rest before tomorrow's tour to Alexandria from Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip from Cairo

Your tour will also take you to the Modern Library of Alexandria, the oldest center of scientific research in history. Founded by Ptolemy I at the beginning of the 3rd century B.C., this library was once the largest in the world. Experience the rich intellectual heritage that emanates from this iconic institution.

Indulge in a delightful seafood lunch at a fancy restaurant overlooking the harbor, savoring the flavors of the Mediterranean.

Finally, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo, where you can relax and reflect on the memorable experiences of your Alexandria day trip.

Day 04: Fly to Aswan - Aswan Nile Cruise
