Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you with a signboard bearing your names. It's time to unwind after a lengthy flight! You'll be driven to your accommodations in a private vehicle with air conditioning. Your representative will assist you with a quick check-in at the hotel and go over the 12-day schedule for the Pyramids, Nile Cruise, and Sharm El-Sheikh Christmas Tours with you to confirm and approve pick-up times for each tour.

Day 2: Pyramids and Saqqara Trip

After enjoying a delicious breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, your dedicated tour guide will meet you to kick off your <u>Cairo Day</u> tour. The first stop will be the renowned <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will be in awe of the Great Pyramid of Cheops. This magnificent structure is the only remaining monument of the seven man-made wonders of the ancient world. You'll also have the chance to see the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, descendants of Cheops, as well as <u>the Great Sphinx</u> and the Valley Temple, which was used for mummification. During the tour, you'll be able to capture stunning panoramic views and take memorable photos. If you're interested, you can even opt for a camel ride around the Giza Pyramids.

Next, we'll head to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, home to the Step Pyramid Complex. This complex is notable for being the first building in the world constructed entirely out of stone. You'll have the opportunity to explore the Djoser <u>Step Pyramid</u> and marvel at its architectural significance. Additionally, the tour includes a visit to the pyramid of Teti, known for its magnificent interior, and the Tombs of the Nobles at Saqqara. These tombs provide a glimpse into the daily life and activities of ancient Egypt, with their walls and corridors adorned with inscriptions and paintings that have survived for over 4,000 years.

After a satisfying lunch, our journey continues to Memphis, the former capital of the pharaohs for a millennium. This city held immense religious and cultural importance during the three thousand years of ancient Egyptian civilization. At the open-air museum in Memphis, you'll discover the famous alabaster sphinx, the second-largest sphinx made from an 80-ton block of marble. Additionally, you'll see the colossal broken statue of Ramses II, an impressive sight that reflects the grandeur of ancient

Egypt.

As the day comes to a close, you'll return to your hotel in Cairo for a well-deserved rest and overnight stay.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan - Aswan Tours

Early in the morning, check out and make your way to Cairo International Airport. traveling to <u>Aswan</u> by air. Your transfer to the Cruise will be met by one of our local staff members. Before noon, we will set sail, and you can eat on the boat. Begin your <u>Aswan day tours</u> by visiting <u>the High Dam</u>, which was inaugurated in 1971, and the <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was constructed on an amazing island. After that, we'll set sail for Kom Ombo. After taking your afternoon tea, visit the temple that is shared by the two gods Sobek and Haroeris. In order to see the most beautiful temples in Egypt, we will sail towards <u>Edfu</u>. On the cruise ship, your meal will be served. Enjoy a disco Party at the conclusion of the day.

Day 4: Edfu Temple Tour

After breakfast is served on board your deluxe Nile cruise, we'll visit Edfu's Temple of Horus, which is the most beautiful structure honoring Horus, the falcon-headed god of the sky and monarchy who was worshipped in ancient Egypt. You will next cross the lock and set sail for <u>Luxor</u>. You can now take pleasure in your afternoon tea and meals onboard. You'll go to the Galabya celebration.

Day 5: Luxor Nile Cruise Tour

Next, you'll visit the impressive Temple of Deir el-Bahari, also known as the Temple of Hatshepsut. This temple is a marvel of ancient Egyptian architecture, with its terraces and colonnades blending harmoniously with the surrounding cliffs. Learn about the fascinating history of Queen Hatshepsut, one of Egypt's most powerful female rulers.

Continuing the tour on the East Bank of Luxor, you'll visit the majestic <u>Karnak Temple</u> complex. This is where Moses received the Ten Commandments. The Greek Orthodox Church owns and operates the Saint Catherine monastery, which is surrounded by gardens and cypress trees. After the Vatican, this huge library is home to the second-largest collection of illuminated manuscripts in the world. The Burning Bush and several old works of art, including priceless icons, exquisitely carved doors, lovely wall murals, and other magnificent religious embellishments, are visible.
