#### <u>Itinerary</u>

#### **Day 1: Arrival Cairo**

The leader of Cairo Top Tours is waiting for you at Cairo International Airport to help you with the arrival procedures and chauffer you to start your fantastic Egypt trip. Our tour guide will be waiting for you at <a href="Cairo International Airport">Cairo International Airport</a> with a sign bearing your name, ready to help you with all the requirements when you arrive in Egypt. You will travel in an opulent, air-conditioned car from the airport to your accommodation.

Our tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will assist you with a smooth check-in process when you arrive at the hotel. He will go over your package schedule with you to confirm the times for each of the various airlines' pick-ups.

#### Day 2: Giza pyramids and Egyptian Museum

When you have finished your hotel breakfast, the tour guide will pick you up in a comfortable, air-conditioned car to start your special journey. Our first destination on the journey will be the <u>Great Sphinx</u> and the Pyramids of Giza, two of the Seven Wonders of the World. During this trip, you will view the largest statue in the world, designed like a lion with the head of a pharaoh to represent the strength and intellect of the king.

Then, to view the most important and well-known antiques that will amaze you and take your mind back in time to experience the pharaohs' former way of life, we'll proceed to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Tahrir.

Some of the most well-known objects are the gems and jewelry that belonged to King <u>Tutankhamun</u> and other monarchs and queens.

Then, after finished, we'll grab lunch at a nearby neighborhood restaurant.

Once we are done, we will return to your hotel in Cairo.

#### **Day 3: Coptic Cairo tour**

After breakfast, your private guide will pick you up at your Cairo hotel. Then you will begin seeing the Cave Church, one of the most important churches in Egypt, and the site of the monastery of <u>St. Simon Tanner</u>, whose ideas you were influenced by.

As the people saw in a paranormal event, the mountain is carved into the Mokattam Mountain, southeast of Cairo, and you have to go through it to reach the church. You will enjoy exploring <u>Coptic</u>

<u>Cairo</u> with your own driver and professional guide after a delicious meal. You will also enjoy visiting the remnants of the old Roman fortress of Babylon and the Virgin Mary-focused <u>Hanging Church</u>, which dates back to the third century.

Examples of the horn, that is, on the two main towers of the castle, are the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u> in Coptic Cairo, which is probably the site of the Pharaoh's palace where the Prophet Moses, peace be upon him, was, and the Church of Mar, beneath which the Holy Family resides in the cave. It was taken from the Nile River in the days of the ancient Egyptians.

You will be taken back to your lodging when your trip is finished.

## Day 4: Wadi El Natrun monasteries tour/ travel to Alexandria

After breakfast, your private guide will pick you up at your Cairo hotel. The <u>Wadi El-Natrun</u> <u>monasteries</u>, which are located along the path from Cairo to Alexandria and acted as the monks' final line of defense against the Berbers and Bedouins, will be the next stop on your journey.

We'll then head to Alexandria so you can spend the rest of the evening checking into your hotel.

#### **Day 5: Alexandria tour**

Following breakfast in the early morning at your lodging.

Your daily journey will start with a halt, where your auto guide will be waiting to greet you. We will next visit the <u>Monastery of St. Mark</u>, an Alexandrian church that bears the name of Mark, the Coptic Orthodox Church's founder. Next visit the Roman-era <u>Kom El Shoqafa tombs</u>, located in the Karmouz district west of Alexandria.

After, treat yourself to a seafood feast at a nearby restaurant. Next, see the famous <u>Qaitbay Citadel</u> in Alexandria, which dates back more than 500 years and is located at the westernmost tip of Pharos Island.

After the trip, we'll head back to your accommodation in Cairo.

#### Day 6: Travel to Sinai, Saint Catherine

After breakfast, your private guide will pick you up at your Cairo hotel in the early morning.

We started our adventure in <u>Sinai</u>, where one of the most popular tourist destinations, the 12 springs of Nabi Musa, will be the first stop on your tour. The water in the area is safe to drink, and the winters and summers are pleasant. Then you will notice Saint Catherine.

The monastery is among Egypt's most well-known monasteries.

Once lunch is over, you'll be transported to a restaurant and then dropped off at your hotel for the night.

#### **Day 7: Climbing Mount Sinai**

Early the next day,

Assume that you will ascend the magnificent <u>Mount Sinai</u> on your seventh day, which coincides with receiving the Ten Commandments, according to the Torah, the Bible, and the Qur'an. Therefore, once you have eaten breakfast at your hotel, get ready for a long day.

With your own guide, we'll return to Cairo at the end of the day.

#### Day 8: Final departure

After breakfast at the hotel, you will check out of the accommodation and get ready to be driven to Cairo International Airport for your last departure. You can reserve any of our excursions around Cairo at this time if you have any free time.
