Day 1: Arrive in Cairo, Check-In

Egypt's capital city of Cairo is where we will be landing today. We're going to settle in and check into our hotel.

After assisting you with all the processes at Cairo International Airport, Cairo Top Tours will take you to your hotel, where you will make your reservation and spend the night. Day 2: Memphis, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids

On day 2 Following breakfast at the hotel, you and your group tour will see Memphis, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids.

Any visitor to Egypt must see the Giza Pyramids. They are among the most well-known landmarks in Egypt and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. While there has been much conjecture throughout the years regarding the exact purpose of these pyramids, they were originally constructed as pharaohs' tombs. You will have the opportunity to explore Memphis, a historic city that was the capital of Egypt throughout its Old Kingdom era (2686 - 2181 B.C.), in addition to getting a close-up look at these amazing structures. Additionally, you'll get time to see Saqqara, a significant necropolis in southern Egypt.

You'll also get time to see Saqqara, a significant necropolis in southern Egypt that is well-known for the step pyramid that King Djoser erected in 2630 BC and which served as a mausoleum for numerous pharaohs. Explore another nobleman's tomb at Saqqara, owned by the son-in-law of the sixth-dynasty king Teti.

Day 3: Tours of Alexandria, Cairo to Alexandria

After breakfast, you will head off early in the morning with your authorized tour guide to explore Alexandria, which was named the most beautiful city in the world for centuries and was built in 332 B.C. by Alexander the Great, a well-known leader of the Greco-Roman era. Once you arrive, you will first view the Pompey Pillar and then the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, which were formerly the tombs of Egyptian nobles and are now open to the public. The art style that combined elements of Roman and Pharaonic art will astound you.

Continue your day journey to Alexandria from Cairo to view the Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the site of the historic Lighthouse Pharos, which is now destroyed but was once considered one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

After enjoying a delicious lunch of fresh seafood at one of Alexandria's most elegant eateries with a view of the bay, you will go to the contemporary Bibliotheca of Alexandria to experience one of the most stunning architectural feats in modern history.

Transfer now to your hotel for check-in and overnight.

Day 4: Alexandria to Marsa Matrouh and El-Alamein WWII Cemetery

After breakfast, make your way to El Alamein to enjoy your tour of the site of the two major Second World War battles between the Allied and Axis forces. See the Military Museum to learn more, visit the WWII Commonwealth Cemetery, and then head to the lovely Mediterranean city of Marsa Matrouh for a delicious lunch of Egyptian cuisine. After that, spend some time relaxing on the beach. check-in, and spend the night.

Enjoy a delicious breakfast at the Marsa Matrouh hotel, then take the rest of the day to yourself.

Day 6: Cairo City Tour and Marsa Matrouh to Cairo

You will be driven back to Cairo in your own air-conditioned car after breakfast. Once you arrive, your first stop on your Cairo city tour will be the Egyptian Museum, located in Tahrir Square. This structure is home to over 120,000 artifacts spanning various periods of Egypt's history. The King Tutankhamun's priceless golden collection will astound you.

Proceed to Old Cairo to begin your tour of Coptic Cairo. First, see the first-century-old Roman fortress of Babylon, which is topped by the Coptic Orthodox Church known as the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin

Mary, which is perched atop two of the fortress's towers. See the Ben Ezra Synagogue and the Abu Serga Cave Church as well. Before being taken to your hotel for the night, have lunch. For greater respect for those places of worship, Cairo Top Tours advised visitors to dress loosely and long. Women might consider wearing veils when entering mosques.
