The White Desert and its unusual rock formations can be explored at Bahariya Oasis, where you will next take a plane.

Following that, you will travel to Luxor, a city well-known for its historic temples, including the Valley of the Kings and the Karnak Temple Complex, and then on to Aswan, where you will visit [the Philae Temple](#), which is located on an island in Lake Nasser. After that, stop in Hurghada to admire the Red Sea's stunning blue hue. This tour is intended for parties of people who wish to enjoy themselves while learning about Egypt's amazing landmarks and natural wonders.

Day 1: Arrive in Cairo, Check-In

Egypt's capital city of Cairo is where we will be landing today. We're going to settle in and check into our hotel.

After assisting you with all the procedures at Cairo International Airport, Cairo Top Tours will take you to your hotel, where you will make your reservation and spend the night. Please let us know as soon as possible if there are any changes you would like to make to the pick-up times on your itinerary for the 7-day Cairo, Alexandria, and Marsa Matrouh group tour package.

Welcome Drink.

Day 2: Tours of Cairo and the Pyramids.

You will take a tour of the Giza Pyramids in the morning. These structures date back to the 4th Dynasty (2613–2494 BC), and they are regarded as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. The Great Sphinx of Giza, a human-headed lion with a lion's body that is 20 meters (65 feet) high and 73 meters (240 feet) long, is another sight to behold. Pharaoh Khafra carved it out of limestone. Since 2500 BC, this magnificent limestone statue—one of the biggest in the world—has guarded the city. You will have enough time to capture memories of these enjoyable day trips around Cairo, including riding a camel.

Following your tour of the Sphinx and Pyramids, you will go to the Egyptian Museum, which has one of the largest collections of ancient Egyptian artifacts in the world. The museum is filled with items from Egypt's

rich past and culture, such as jewelry, sarcophagi, mummies, and statues created by the most well-known ancient Egyptian artists. King Tutankhamun's tomb and relics from every previous Egyptian dynasty are among its many treasures.

following a meal at a nearby restaurant. Next, proceed to the oldest area of Cairo, known as the Coptic Cairo tour. Here, you will witness some of the most significant churches in Egypt, such as St. Mark's Cathedral and St. Sergius Church, in addition to some historical sites, such as St. Peter & St. Paul Church and Al-Azhar Mosque, which is the oldest mosque in Egypt.

We're going to take you to see:

The Church that Hangs:

Built on top of an ancient Roman fortress in Babylon, this church is devoted to the Holy Virgin Mary and is known in Arabic as Al Moallaqa, which translates to "the hanging" or "the suspended church" in English.

Church of Abu Serga:

After that, you'll have to stroll a short distance to see this magnificent church—one of Egypt's oldest and most significant—that commemorates the holy family's visit to this region.

Lastly, you will see the ancient Jewish Synagogue of Ben Ezra with our Egyptologist guide:

It was once a Coptic church before being bought by a Jewish man from Jerusalem, who turned it into a synagogue bearing his name. After that, your helpful guide will take you to your accommodation.

Spend the night in a hotel in Cairo.

Day 3: Tour of the White Desert

Following your delectable breakfast, your personal Egyptologist guide will take you on the White Desert Egypt tour.

The chalk and limestone layer that covers a portion of the white desert is what gives the area its name. Even at night, it is incredibly charming, magical, and white. Because the oasis is well-known for its palm trees and fruit gardens, you will see the salt lake, golden sand dunes, and lush, green date palm groves! then, after going through the Black Desert, we head to the White Desert:

The black desert's name originated from the Valley of El Haize and the black powder that covered its mountains due to the eruption of dolerite, a dark volcanic substance.

Approximately 50 kilometers south of Bawiti is the Bahariya Oasis's central village.

See the quartz crystal at Crystal Mountain by stopping by:

This region, which is roughly 160 km from Bahariya Oasis, is known as the "jewel of the desert" due to the abundance of over 12 different kinds of crystal. and the magnificent Ashgabat Valley. Camping in the White Desert is an excellent experience. Savor your delicious meal while taking in the breathtaking sunset.

Day 4: Tour of Bahariya Oasis

Before your White Desert tour ends, enjoy breakfast in the desert. After that, you'll travel to explore the White Desert area, where you'll see a variety of stunning formations, including trees, tents, chickens, rabbits, and mushrooms. This is a great opportunity for you to take some pictures of the amazing limestone rocks and formations. after which head back to Bahariya Oasis. Prepare for your overnight transfer from Bahariya to your hotel in Cairo, where our tour guide will pick you up in a luxury air-conditioned car.

Day 5: Aswan Sightseeing Tours from Cairo to Aswan

Following breakfast, we will drive you to Cairo International Airport so you can fly to Aswan. When you arrive, our representative will greet you and assist you with checking into the airport. After that, you will meet your English-speaking tour guide to begin your Aswan sightseeing tour, which will include a visit to the Aswan High Dam.

One of our former presidents, Gamal Abdel Nasser, started construction on it in 1960 and finished it in 1971 in order to save Egypt's electric power and protect the country from floods. then a trip to the Temple of Philae:

One of the few remaining temples where the ancient Egyptian religion was practiced after Christianity spread throughout Egypt, it was constructed with the purpose of worshipping the goddess Isis. Once the Aswan day tours are over, you'll head to your Aswan hotel to spend the night.
