Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Day

An important landmark in Egypt is <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, a limestone statue with the body of a lion and the head of a human. Pharaoh Sneferu constructed it, but it's still unfinished. <u>Memphis</u> holds great significance as the capital from the Third to the Sixth Dynasties.

Day 3: Old Cairo tour.

The third day will be spent touring some of Cairo's top attractions. That's when this will commence.

One of the Middle East's oldest and most well-known archaeological museums is the <u>Egyptian</u> <u>Museum</u>. It is home to a sizable collection of antiquities from ancient Egypt, spanning the classical and prehistoric eras. This historical treasure trove offers a singular and engrossing look into the cultural legacy of one of the oldest civilizations on Earth.

One of the earliest medieval military strongholds, <u>the Saladin Citadel</u> is a prominent historical site in <u>Islamic Cairo</u>. It is a well-liked tourist destination and a useful source of knowledge about Islamic history.
