## Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Sound and Light Show in Giza Pyramids

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our tour leader who will be waiting for you will meet you to be transferred to the hotel in Cairo for the check-in procedures to be done quickly in case you want to have some rest after your international flight. He will review the details of your 5 Days Cairo and Alexandria Honeymoon Itinerary to make sure everything is going according to the schedule.

An optional tour to attend the <u>sound and light show in Giza Pyramids</u> will be available to be booked by your tour manager, this is a great chance to learn a good background about the <u>history of Egypt</u> in a simple laser-data show.

## Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Your second day on this enchanting journey begins at the Giza Plateau, where Giza Pyramids stand proudly against the desert horizon. Marvel at the architectural brilliance of the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the enigmatic Pyramid of Khafre, and the smaller Pyramid of Menkaure.

After a delightful Egyptian lunch, venture to the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, an archaeological treasure trove that predates the Giza Pyramids. Explore <u>the Step Pyramid</u> of Djoser, the oldest stone pyramid in Egypt, and witness the evolution of pyramid design.

Conclude your day with a visit to <u>Memphis</u>, the ancient capital of Egypt. Stroll through the open-air museum, where colossal statues and relics narrate the stories of bygone eras.

## **Day 3: Alexandria Day Trip from Cairo**

After having breakfast at the hotel you will meet up with your licensed tour guide to start exploring <u>Alexandria attractions</u> as you will take the Alexandria Desert Road for almost 3 hours drive including a coffee break. Upon arrival, you will fall in love with the beautiful city of <u>Alexandria</u> which was founded in 332 B.C. by the famous Macedonian leader Alexander the Great and remains the capital of Egypt for almost 1000 years.

First, you will see <u>Pompey's Pillar</u> which is located within the ruined Serapeum of Alexandria, transfer to see <u>the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, which is an ancient catacomb comprised of 3 floors under the ground and ornamented from the inside with a mixture of Pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles of art and architecture.

Transfer to the Citadel of Qaitbay which is built by the ruined stones of the ancient <u>Lighthouse Pharos</u>. We will pass by the modern <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u> on our way to enjoy a pleasant seafood lunch meal in a restaurant overlooking the seawater.

We will take the vehicle back to Cairo for an overnight stay.

### Day 4: Egyptian Museum, Cairo Citadel, Khan El Khalili

After your breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your guide to begin your <u>Cairo day tours</u> by the Egyptian Museum tour, see the most ancient artifacts inside <u>the Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo which was opened to the public in 1902 to house the biggest collection of ancient artifacts.

Resume your excursions in Cairo to visit <u>Salah El Din Citadel</u>, a Medieval Cairo fortification built by the Muslim Sultan Saladin Al Ayyubi. You will be surprised by the size of its towers before entering the alabaster <u>Mosque Of Muhammad Ali</u> inside, the citadel was built during the 12th century to be the center of ruling the country for about 700 years.

Finally, after having your tasty lunch, you will be transferred to the oldest market in Cairo for an amazing shopping experience in the <u>Khan El Khalili</u> bazaar.
