Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation to MS Nile Radamis - East Bank sightseeing

Day 3: Visit Edfu & Kom Ombo temples

Following your visit, the cruise will set sail for Aswan.

On the way, enjoy a delicious lunch as the boat stops at Kom Ombo, an ancient town. Your accredited Egyptologist guide will take you to the Ptolemaic <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. The cruise will then continue down the Nile to Aswan.

Dinner will be served on board in the evening, followed by a Nubian show.

Day 4 : Sightseeing Tour in Aswan

Enjoy a delightful open-buffet breakfast on board before setting off for your <u>Aswan day tours</u>. First, visit the impressive <u>High Dam</u>, built to control the Nile's water flow, conserve water for agriculture, and generate electricity.

Next, explore <u>the Unfinished Obelisk</u> in the granite quarries, believed to have been intended for Queen Hatshepsut but never completed. Conclude your tour with a visit to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, dedicated to the worship of the goddess Isis, showcasing Greco-Roman architectural style.

Savor a delicious lunch in the evening while sailing on the MS Nile Radamis Nile Cruise. Dinner will also be served on board, followed by an overnight stay in the enchanting city of Aswan.
